"Frank P. Zeidler (1912-2006) spent his life as a public servant. Although he was best-known as Milwaukee's mayor from 1948 to 1960, Zeidler served even longer in his unpaid capacities: as a civic activist, local historian, churchman, Socialist Party leader, and conscience of the community. He was a tireless advocate for social justice and a champion of mutual respect and cooperation as the keys to both world peace and civic unity. Frank Zeidler was a citizen in the deepest sense of the word: someone who identified his welfare with the welfare of the world around him and never stopped working for its betterment."
