***WHEREAS,** Daniel Montalvo also finds time to work in the community, as he has organized a Youth Art Gallery for the past three years, and he has helped coach and mentor other debaters on his team; and*

***WHEREAS,** Daniel Montalvo was one of eight finalists for the award out of more than 11,000 student debaters, and he was selected based upon his commitment and dedication to debate, academic excellence and leadership in his school, urban debate league and in the community; now, therefore, be it*
