I am writing to appeal the decision regarding claim # 07-S-283. I was later told that the vehicle would be a total loss based on the damages and current value of the vehicle. To Whom It May Concern:

I, Sharon McCoy-Hunt, am writing in regards to a situation that occurred on June 16, 2007. I was involved in an automobile accident on the night of June 16, 2007. I was escorted to the hospital on the said night by ambulance with my sister. My vehicle was taken by tow truck to the City of Milwaukee tow lot. I spoke with my insurance company and I was advised to find out whether the vehicle was taken to the tow lot and if so sign a release to have my insurance company pick up the vehicle to be inspected. I went to tow lot and completed the necessary forms for the insurance company. I also retrieved some immediate items from the vehicle. The vehicle was picked up by my insurance company two days later. A few days later my insurance called and informed me that the vehicle damage was too costly to repair therefore will not be repaired and deemed a total lost. The same day I went to the insurance tow lot and received the final items from my vehicle and noticed items were missing. When I got home I called the insurance tow lot to go back to the vehicle to look for the sunglass case (that had a pair of Gucci sunglasses, and a diamond necklace within it), my daughters Disney MP3 player and my Apple IPOD, again and there was nothing else found. I then called the City tow lot and asked were the items removed to no avail I was told to call the police department to make a theft report about the missing items. I also called my insurance company to submit a theft claim. As a result, my insurance company covered a partial cost of the missing items because of limitations and provisions within my policy. I was informed that I could submit a claim to the City tow lot to try to retrieve the remaining cost of the missing items. I have included a copy of the description and cost of the missing items.
