Applicant agrees to file a bond and certificate of insurance and to pay a biennial fee of \$22.00 per vending box.


Applicant agrees to keep vending boxes in good repair and shall be primarily liable for damages to persons or property by reason of the granting of a permit.

Applicant waives the right to contest the validity of Section 66.045 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1967.

Applicant agrees to remove vending boxes within a reasonable time after being requested to do so by the City of Milwaukee.

Applicant hereby requests approval to place 10 vending boxes.

Failure to comply with these requirements may result in non-issuance of a permit.
