THE BRIDGE PROJECT

The Bridge Project will provide 100 eligible, low-income, pregnant individuals, living in the 53204, 53205, 53206, and 53215 zip codes with unconditional cash.

No strings attached.

The cash can be spent on anything - food, formula, rent, childcare, diapers—truly, whatever the mother decides. The program duration is two years, beginning June 2024.

HOW DO MOTHERS APPLY?

Applications will be available online beginning APRIL 10, 2024.

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis for eligibility and will remain open until all program slots have been filled. We utilize a randomized computer selection process to select eligible program participants that meet the following criteria:

- 18 years or older.
- 23 weeks pregnant or less.
- Live in 53204, 53205, 53206 or 53215 with priority in Lindsay Heights, Clarke Square or Layton Boulevard West neighborhoods.
- Have an annual household income of less than \$39,000 USD.

PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE

\$1,125 one-time,

upfront prenatal stipend.

\$750 per month

for the first 15 months of program participation.

\$375 per month

for the remaining 9 months of program participation.
