File # 011104 is a resolution authorizing the expenditure of funds from the Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund for the purpose of on-going expert witnesses services relative to the lawsuit of Super Excavators, Inc. v. City of Milwaukee.

Background

- 1. The Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund covers the cost of hiring expert witnesses and outside counsel in legal cases. Funds are approved on a case-bycase basis and appropriated to a sub-account under City Attorney expenditure authority by Common Council resolution.
- 2. This file will authorize the expenditure of \$25,000 by the City Attorney for the purpose of retaining expert witnesses for Case No. 01-CV-001325, Super Excavators, Inc. v. City of Milwaukee.
- 3. In September 2001, the Common Council approved File # 010664 authorizing the expenditure of \$50,000 from the Outside Council/Expert Witness Fund for expert witness services related to this case.
- 4. This resolution also authorizes the City Attorney to pay other litigation expenses related to this lawsuit.

Discussion

- In 1997, the City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works awarded a contract to Super Excavators, Inc. for sewer construction on West Brown Street from North 26th Street to North 29th Street. The contract total was \$5,412,049.
- 2. Super Excavators, Inc. claims that work in excess of \$880,000 was completed beyond the contract parameters. This extra work included excavation of a recovery shaft to retrieve a tunnel-boring machine and resulted in extended expenses for labor, equipment, supplies and overhead.
- 3. This case is presently involved in the discovery process with depositions being taken. No trial date has been set.

- 4. The facts of this case and background needed are scientifically intense with expertise required from technical experts such as engineers, chemists and hydro-geologists.
- 5. With interest added, the claim now stands at +\$1,000,000.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total funding for this resolution is \$25,000 to be appropriated from the Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund.
- 2. If this appropriation is approved, the Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund will have a balance of \$307,000.
- 3. As of December 11, 2001, \$30,186 has been paid for expert services related to this case.
