There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. On 06/25/2025 at 9:10PM, my partner, PO Bryan BOYD and I, Squad #3220, were dispatched to a Fire complaint at the location of 2401 N. 21st Street, which is located within the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival to the aforementioned location, we met with Milwaukee Fire Department Engine 30, (Green Shift LT. POTTER). LT. POTTER stated that the fire was isolated to a large plastic dumpster which was located on the South side of the aforementioned address.

We made contact with the owner of the business, "Lucky Sam Food Mart", verbally identified as Sukehdev SINGH (M/A 09/16/1991). SINGH has security cameras located on the outside of the and had video of the incident. The video showed the suspect appear to light a piece of paper on fire with a lighter, before tossing it into the dumpster. The suspect then walked away in an unknown direction.

Security camera video showed the suspect to be a B/M, 5'8, slim build, approximately 60 y/o, grey messy/medium length hair, wearing a blue baseball cap, orange bandana around his neck, white sweatshirt and blue jeans.

SINGH was provided with an Evidence.com link to upload video of the incident. SINGH was also provided with a PV-17 and community contact card.

Squad #3450, PO Jamie WARNER and PO Taylor ZUBIE responded to the scene to capture photos.

We did not observe any premise violation during the investigation.

On Saturday, April 18, 2026, at approximately 8:20PM P.O. Michael WARD and I were dispatched to 2401 N. 21st St., which is in the City and County of Milwaukee; for a property damage call for service

Upon our arrival we observed there to be nothing going on anymore and that the store was still visibly open for business.

I spoke to the caller, *Ajay MANHAS (w/m, 5-8-97)*. MANHAS stated he has been having issues with 3 juveniles that have been coming to the store and shoplifting as well as knocking things over inside the store. MANHAS stated that he has told the juveniles to not return to the store, but they have not listened. MANHAS stated that he believes they live in the area, but he does not know exactly where.

There was no video of the incident, but MANHAS showed me on his phone photos of the juveniles leaving and of the shelf off chips they knocked over.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date. During my investigation for property damage I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
