Yes, a Certified Survey Map (CSM) in Wisconsin is required to **clearly show the exterior boundaries of the entire original parcel** that is being surveyed and divided, including any portion that will remain unplatted. [🔗](#)

The relevant Wisconsin statute and guidance documents emphasize that the CSM must be a correct and complete representation of the *entire* "land surveyed and divided". The requirements are: [🔗](#)

- **Exterior Boundaries:** The exterior boundaries of the land being divided must be clearly shown, typically with a solid heavy line.
- **Complete Representation:** The surveyor must include a statement certifying that the map is a correct representation of all of the exterior boundaries of the land surveyed
