MWSBE Participation

Ten MWSBE contractors have been awarded contracts to perform work or supply materials totaling \$4,645,353, which is 26% of the Total Construction Cost Subject to Participation. As shown on the table below, many MWSBE have been awarded multiple contracts on this project. To date, these contractors have been paid \$547,542 or 9% of the total construction draw submitted to date. During the next several months, MWSBE contractors will begin installing drywall, HVAC system, supplying electrical equipment, installing doors, cabinets, installing carpeting, continuing plumbing installation and installing the HVAC system. By the end of the project, MWSBE contractor's total payments for work performed on the project are expected to equal 26% of the Total Construction Cost Subject to Participation.

Prevailing Wage

On January 20, 2011, the Department of Workforce Development issued PREVAILING WAGE RATE DETERMINATION Number 201100178 pursuant to s. 66.0904, Wis. Stats.

Each contractor must complete a Workforce Profile Form (a copy of the Workforce Profile Form is attached). The information on the Workforce Profile Form is used to verify that the employer is paying each worker the prevailing wage determined for that worker's classification. The contractor must submit a copy of the apprentice contract for each apprentice. Each contractor is required to submit certified payrolls weekly. The information on the certified payroll is used to again verify the payment of prevailing wages, then entered into a database system that prepares the monthly RPP reports.

As of July 1, 2011, DWD does not require the reporting of prevailing wages.
