2. Darrell C Nicholson is listed as a corporate officer in the corporation applying for this license. Following is his record.

On 8-31-2002 at 9:15pm, officers were dispatched to 11th & Atkinson to investigate "shots fired". They found a large crowd in front of the liquor store, 1101 W Atkinson Ave. While interviewing persons on the scene regarding the shots fired, they observed a person exit the liquor store, with a case of beer, after hours. The owner was not on the premises, but Darrell Nicholson, who was selling was issued the following citation.

3. On 3-15-2003 at 7:15pm an underage Milwaukee Police Aide entered Atkinson Beer & Liquor Store, 1101 W Atkinson Ave at the direction of Milwaukee Police Officers. The aide attempted to purchase a 12 pack of Miller High Life beer from the clerk, but was turned down due to his age. As the aide was leaving the store, he was approached by a doorman/security guard, Joe Lipsey, who stated he would sell him the beer and told him to wait outside. The aide gave Lipsey a ten dollar bill and later Lipsey came outside and gave the aide a 12 pack of Miller beer. Officers recovered a .25 caliber semi-automatic pistol from Lipsey's right rear pocket. Lipsey is a convicted felon and stated that the gun was the store owners gun and that Darrell Nicholson gave him the gun to carry.

Lipsey was arrested for Felon In Possession of Firearm/Carrying Concealed Weapon and issued a citation for Sale To Underage.

4. On 04/02/07 at 5:49 pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting at 1101 W Atkinson Avenue. Investigation revealed a woman was shot in the buttocks while she was outside the store. Officers spoke to the store clerk, Alex Smith, who stated he heard 15-20 shots and believed it was from two different guns. A woman then ran into the store stating she was shot. Officers also spoke to the store owner, Darrell Nicholson, who also stated he heard 15-20 shots fired but did not observe any of the shooters but gave a description of a possible vehicle involved. Police were able to obtain a tape from the surveillance camera.

> 11.On 02/12/2015 Milwaukee police assisted the Wisconsin Department of Revenue with a delinquent tax warrant at 1101 West Atkinson Avenue (Atkinson Beer & Liquor Mart). During this investigation, a clear bag containing a green leafy substance, later determined to be marijuana, was discovered in the rear of the store. This substance was confiscated and inventoried by officers, who could not determine the substance's owner. Additionally, two handguns were discovered in a safe. The applicant stated these guns belong to a customer, but he declined to name the owner. These guns were also confiscated by officers. Agents for the Department of Revenue seized \$8771.00 in US currency.

- 12. From 01/01/2015 to 12/09/2015 officers conducted 15 field interviews of subject loitering in front of 1101 W. Atkinson Av. A Check revealed the applicant did not call regarding any of these complaints.
- 13.On 09/09/2015 at 6:16pm officers responded to a call of a shooting at N. 14th St and W. Atkinson Av. A victim was located at 3633 N. 11th St. The officers responded to 1101 W. Atkinson Av to check for video regarding the shooting. The applicant was cooperative with the investigation and allowed the officers to observe the video. The video showed the victim had been inside the store just prior to the shooting.

14. On 11/22/2016 officers assisted the State of Wisconsin Department of Revenue in serving a search warrant at Atkinson Beer and Liquor, 1101 W. Atkinson Av. The Department of Revenue seized money regarding the search warrant. The only violation observed was the current liquor license was not displayed.

15. On 10/17/2019 at 8:36pm officers conducted a licensed premise check at Atkinson Beer and Liquor Mart, 1101 W. Atkinson Av. The applicant was on scene and provided the officers with his liquor license. He stated it is unusual to see officers this late at night but requested they stop in more often.

16. On 03/01/21 at 6:04pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 1101 W. Atkinson Avenue. No violations were found and the applicant was cooperating with the police.

17. On 07/19/21 at 7:44pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 1101 W. Atkinson Avenue. Before entering the establishment, officers observed several people who were standing near or outside the store and left as officers approached. Officers interviewed the applicant inside who asked for more police presence to help keep loitering to a minimum. No violations were reported.

- 18. On 03/15/23 at 1:07p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 1101 W. Atkinson Av. This was in regards to officers' observations as well as complaints of loitering in front of the store. The agent was on scene and the officer advised them of the reason for the license premise check. The agent appeared to become agitated and stated they call for police when people are loitering and stated they filled out a standing complaint from, however, the officer checked the calls for service and standing complaint file and found none. The agent was advised to call for police when people are loitering and was emailed a standing complaint form. As of the date of the report the officer had not received the complaint from back.
- 19. On 04/24/23 at 8:19p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 1101 W. Atkinson Av. On arrival officers observed people loitering both inside and outside of the store. The officers made contact with the agent and requested the business licenses, which the agent pulled out of an envelope. The agent was advised they licenses should be posted. The agent was further advised regarding the loiterers.
- 20. On 07/01/23 at 4:15p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 1101 W. Atkinson Av. This was in regard to complaints of drug dealing and illegal food sales outside of the location. On arrival officers observed multiple people loitering both inside and outside the store. The officer's made contact with the agent and interviewed them regarding the drug dealing. The agent stated they were aware drug transactions were conducted in the alley of the business, however, was not going to approach the subject as they had done so in the past and things went bad for the agent. The officers did observe the license's to be posted, however, not in a visible manner.

On Wednesday, March 15th, 2023, at 1:07 PM, myself and PO Christopher SCHLEI in Squad 5264 conducted a Business Check at 1101 W Atkinson Ave (Atkinson Beer and Liquor), located within the City and County of Milwaukee. This business currently possesses a Class A Malt & Liquor License and a Cigarette Tobacco license which are active until 2/9/2024.

On Tuesday, March 14th, 2023, while on unrelated assignments, I drove past Atkinson Beer and Liquor on multiple occasions where I observed five to six subjects loitering directly in front of the business. I observed the same subjects standing outside the business several hours apart. That same day I received a citizen complaint regarding subjects loitering at the business.

As I arrived at the location on 3/15/23 with PO SCHLEI, we again observed multiple subjects standing outside the business. As we parked our marked squad car, several subjects walked away from the entrance of the business. When we entered the store, I made contact with the licensing agent who identified himself as Darrell C JOHNSON (B/M, 10/16/1967). I informed JOHNSON I was doing a business check and he promptly escorted us to the cashier of the business and produced the Cigarette and Tobacco License. (CIG-1031636)

I informed JOHNSON the reason for my visit was the presence of people loitering outside his store on multiple occasions. JOHNSON appeared to become agitated and stated he calls police when people are loitering, but the responding officers do not issue citations. A CAD search revealed zero calls for service at 1101 W Atkinson Ave regarding subjects loitering from 3/16/2022 to 3/16/2023. I asked JOHNSON if he has submitted a Standing Complaint Form and he stated that he did. JOHNSON also directed my attention to a small no loitering sign affixed to the front door. JOHNSON also stated that when he attempts to disperse subjects from the front of his store, subjects become mad at him. I advised JOHNSON to call for police when subjects are loitering if he feels unsafe asking them to leave.

After returning to District Five, I reviewed the standing complaint forms on file. I was unable to locate any standing complaint for submitted by NICHOLSON for his business. I emailed JOHNSON a blank standing complaint form to the email address he provided me (mperry0404@yahoo.com) with specific instructions for completing it. As of 3/16/23, I have not yet received a response.

This report was written by PO Nora BURLO, assigned to District Five. On 4/24/23, I was assigned to Squad 5468 along with my partner PO James TERRELL. On the listed date, at approximately 8:19PM, PO TERRELL and I conducted a Tavern/ Licensed Premise check at the address 1101 W Atkinson Av (Atkinson Beer & Liquor Mart). The listed location is a licensed premise in the City of Milwaukee. Squad 5446, PO Brandon BUKOVSKY assisted us with the check.

Upon officers' arrival at the location, we observed several individuals outside of the location, loitering in the street, as well as several vehicles. The area is known for high foot and vehicle traffic.

Upon our entering the listed address, officers observed approximately five (5) individuals inside of the store watching the Milwaukee Bucks basketball game. PO TERRELL and I made contact with a male subject who was behind the employee area operating the cash register. He stated he is the owner at the location and provided me with his identification. He was identified as Darrell C NICHOLSON (b/m, 10/16/67), he is also the listed agent for the business. NICHOLSON provided officers with the store's Class A Malt & Liquor license (#0200467) which expires 2/9/24. I also observed the Cigarette & Tobacco license (# 1031635). NICHOLSON stated the store is family run and has been at the location for approximately twenty (20) years. He stated the store is open seven (7) days a week from 9:00AM to 9:00 PM.

I asked NICHOLSON which individuals inside of the store work there. He pointed out the two employees assisting him for the evening. I then made contact with a male subject identified as Jamonte D THACKER (b/m, 4/3/92) who stated his responsibilities are stocking and cleaning up the store. I observed him to be cleaning the glass mirrors. THACKER stated he has worked at the location for eight (8) to ten (10) years. He stated he works five (5) to seven (7) days a week at various hours. He indicated he works more as needed and when he is called. I attempted to make contact with the second employee NICHOLSON pointed out to me. I did not observe him inside of the store. Officers then exited the store, and I located

the second employee, identified as Hazziq I LIPHFORD (b/m, 3/2/77). LIPHFORD stated he has worked at the store, as a stockman, for approximately one and a half to two (2) years. He stated he works various hours, seven (7) days a week.

Officers observed the location to be clean and orderly in the customer portion of the store. Behind the employee area of the location, officers observed several stacks of paper and envelopes. When NICHOLSON provided officers with the licenses, I observed him remove the papers from an envelope. They were not posted anywhere. PO TERRELL advised him to post them.

I informed NICHOLSON that PO TERRELL and I will be increasing patrols in the area due to the high amount of vehicle and foot traffic, as well as loiterers outside of the store. NICHOLSON was then provided with a contact card.

On Saturday, July 01, 2023, at approximately 4:15PM, Police Officer Stephen COLWELL (Squad 5266) and I, Police Officer Keith GARLAND (Squad 5166) responded to 1101 W. Atkinson Ave (Atkinson Beer & Liquor Mart) to conduct an Investigation regarding several complaints of drug dealing/illegal food sells outside of the location.

Prior to responded to the location, CPU received complaints from the residents who leave near the intersection of N. 11th St/ W. Atkinson Ave. The complainants wanted to remain anonymous because of the fear of retaliation. The complainants stated that neighbor subjects conduct drugs transactions on a daily basis outside of the business, on the sidewalk and the alleyway. It should be noted that the sidewalk that the citizen referenced is located on the Southwest corner of the intersection of N. 11th St/ W. Atkinson Ave, near the business's main, front door entrance. The alleyway is located directly behind the business's rear door entrance.

Officer COLWELL and I arrived at the business at approximately 2:49PM, I observed that multiple subjects were loitering outside of the business, who did not appear to be customers. Upon entering inside of the business, I observed two subjects congregating near the front door entrance, and the subjects exited the business, and began loitering outside of the business.

Officer COLWELL spoke to the business agent who was identified as Darrell C. NICHOLSON (B/M, 10/16/1967). Officer COLWELL asked NICHOLSON if he was aware of the subjects who sold drugs outside of his business, and he stated that he was aware of the issue. NICHOLSON stated that the subject's sold drugs in the alleyway that was behind his business. NICHOLSON stated he was not going to approach the subjects to inform them that their illegal activity was unwanted because he'd done that in the past and things went bad, and he was arrested for being in possession of his firearm.

I observed that the business's licenses were located behind the encased security glass cash register area, and the licenses were not in plain view to be read. The licenses were located on the West wall of the cash register area toward the top of ceiling. The two business licenses (Class A Malt & Class A Liquor License and Cigarette and Tobacco) were valid.


