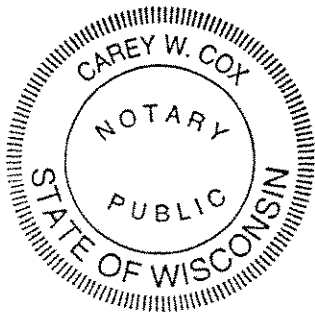

Leonhardt, City Clerk of the City of Milwaukee, certify that pursuant to Section 4-06-3 of the Milwaukee City Charter, notice is given of the passage of the following ordinances by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee on 02/28/2006, with the approval of Mayor Tom Barrett. The full text of each of the ordinances listed below can be obtained at the Office of the City Clerk, Room 205, City Hall, 200 E. Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, 53202.

051389...An ordinance relating to times during which certain Class "A" fermented malt beverage retail licensees may sell to employees.

041402...A substitute ordinance relating to zoning regulations for certain types of group living facilities.

051418...A substitute ordinance relating to procedures for denial, renewal, non-renewal, suspension and revocation of junk dealer and junk collector licenses.

031398...Ordinance to rescind the ordinances changing West Juneau Avenue between North 17th Street and North 18th Street and a portion of West McKinley Avenue between North 17th Street and North 18th Street to Pedestrian Mall, in the 4th Aldermanic District of the City of Milwaukee. (Infrastructure Services Division)

050700...Substitute ordinance relating to the change in zoning from Downtown-Residential and Specialty Use (C9B(a)) and Downtown-Mixed Activity (C9C) to Two-Family Residential (RT4), Local Business (LB2) and Industrial Mixed (IM), located generally North of

East Pleasant Street and West of North Commerce Street, in the 6th Aldermanic District.

051369...A substitute ordinance to grant an airspace lease to the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee for a skywalk to be constructed over West Cherry Street between North Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive and the former North 2nd Street.

050516...A substitute ordinance relating to nonpayment of a motor bus transportation fare.

051115...A substitute ordinance to convert a portion of West Wells Street from North 6th Street to North 10th Street and West State Street from North 6th Street to North 11th Street to North 11th Street from one-way to two-way operation.

051324...A substitute ordinance relating to parking controls in various Aldermanic Districts.

051325...A substitute ordinance relating to traffic controls in various Aldermanic Districts.

051411...A substitute ordinance relating to the definition of luxury limousine and establishing certain appeal hearing procedures under public passenger vehicle regulations.

051414...An ordinance relating to the appeal of special charges imposed by the commissioner of neighborhood services against premises for the violation of solid waste regulations.

051157...Substitute ordinance to further amend the 2006 rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service under control of the Common Council.

051228...Substitute ordinance to further amend the 2006 offices and positions in the City Service under control of the Common Council.

051397...A substitute charter ordinance relating to retirement benefits.

051270...A substitute ordinance relating to election commission service fees.
