AMENDMENT TO COLLECTION SERVICES FOR RECEIVABLES OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE DATED JANUARY 7, 2002

RECITALS

- A. The parties entered into a Collection Services for Receivables of the City of Milwaukee Agreement dated January 7, 2002.
- B. The parties amended the agreement on June 12, 2002 to provide for a trial or pilot program for the collection of delinquent real estate taxes on property for the year 2000 levy.
- C. The parties agree to make the pilot program permanent for the collection of delinquent real estate taxes for current and future tax year levies. The parties agree to a collection cycle of 180 days. For files uncollected within that period, the City shall determine which files shall be included in lawsuits to be brought by the Kohn Law Firm and which files shall be returned to the City for inclusion in an *in rem* action.

AMENDMENT

In consideration of the mutual promises of the parties, Article VII, Fees, of the agreement dated January 7, 2002, Sections 1.e. and f. are added to read as follows:

- 1. Personal and real property taxes:
- e. On all claims for collection of delinquent real estate taxes, 10% of the amount collected pre-lawsuit on all accounts having an initial balance under \$5,000.00 and 8% of the amount collected pre-lawsuit on all accounts having an initial balance over \$5,000.00.
