
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Richard Blaha, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a fully marked Milwaukee Police squad car that was traveling northbound on North 27th Street with its lights and siren activated. As the City Vehicle proceeded through the intersection of North 27th Street and West Capital Drive, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding westbound on West Capital drive, failed to yield the right of way, improperly passed a vehicle on the right and entered the intersection causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Blaha sustained injuries to his left leg, left knee and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$13,731.90.
