REASON FOR REQUEST:

Richard Blaha, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a fully marked Milwaukee Police squad car that was traveling northbound on North 27<sup>th</sup> Street with its lights and siren activated. As the City Vehicle proceeded through the intersection of North 27<sup>th</sup> Street and West Capital Drive, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding westbound on West Capital drive, failed to yield the right of way, improperly passed a vehicle on the right and entered the intersection causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Blaha sustained injuries to his left leg, left knee and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$13,731.90.
