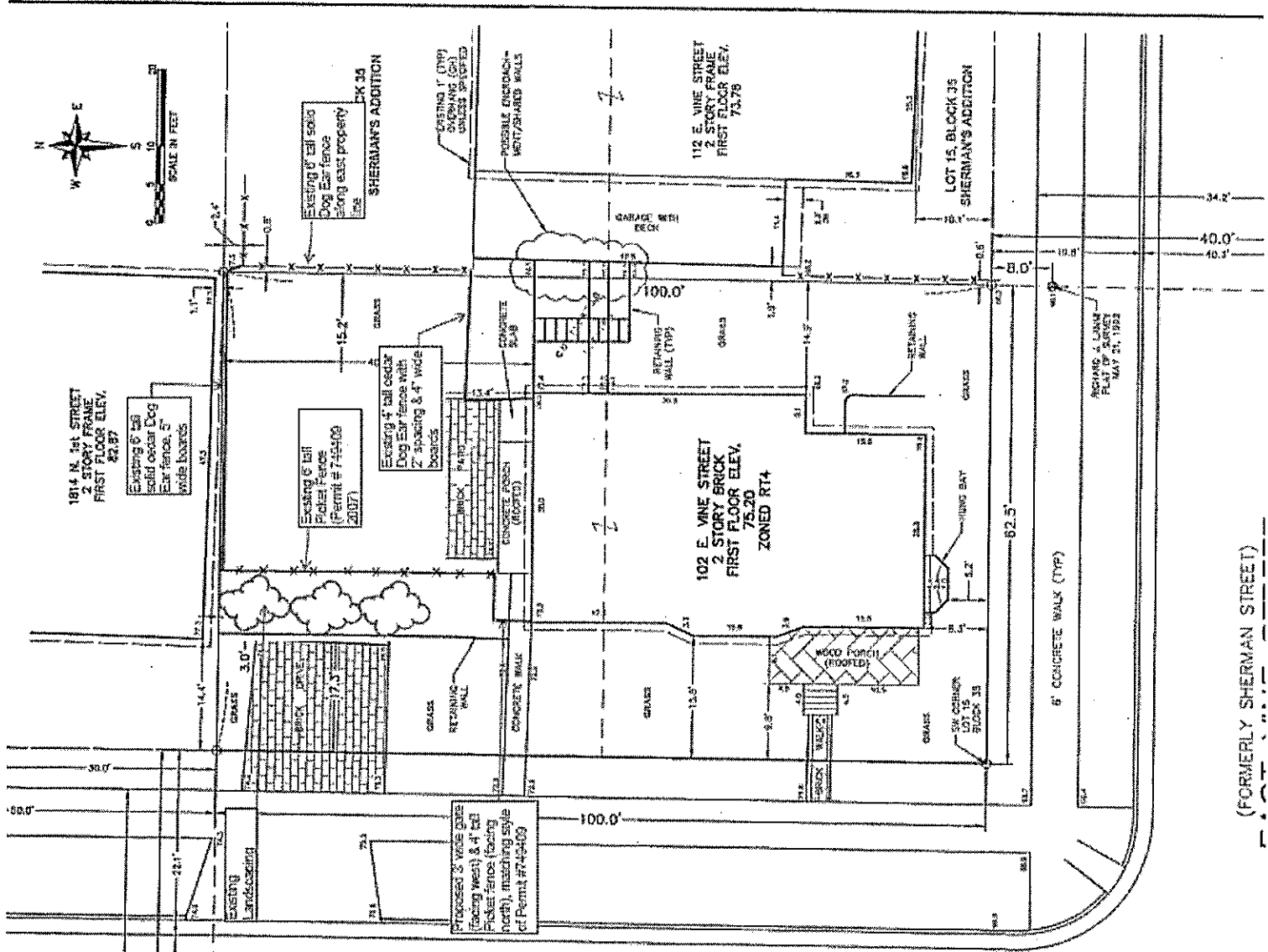
All work will be done according to the specifications and illustrations contained in this COA. Fence will be painted or stained upon completion.

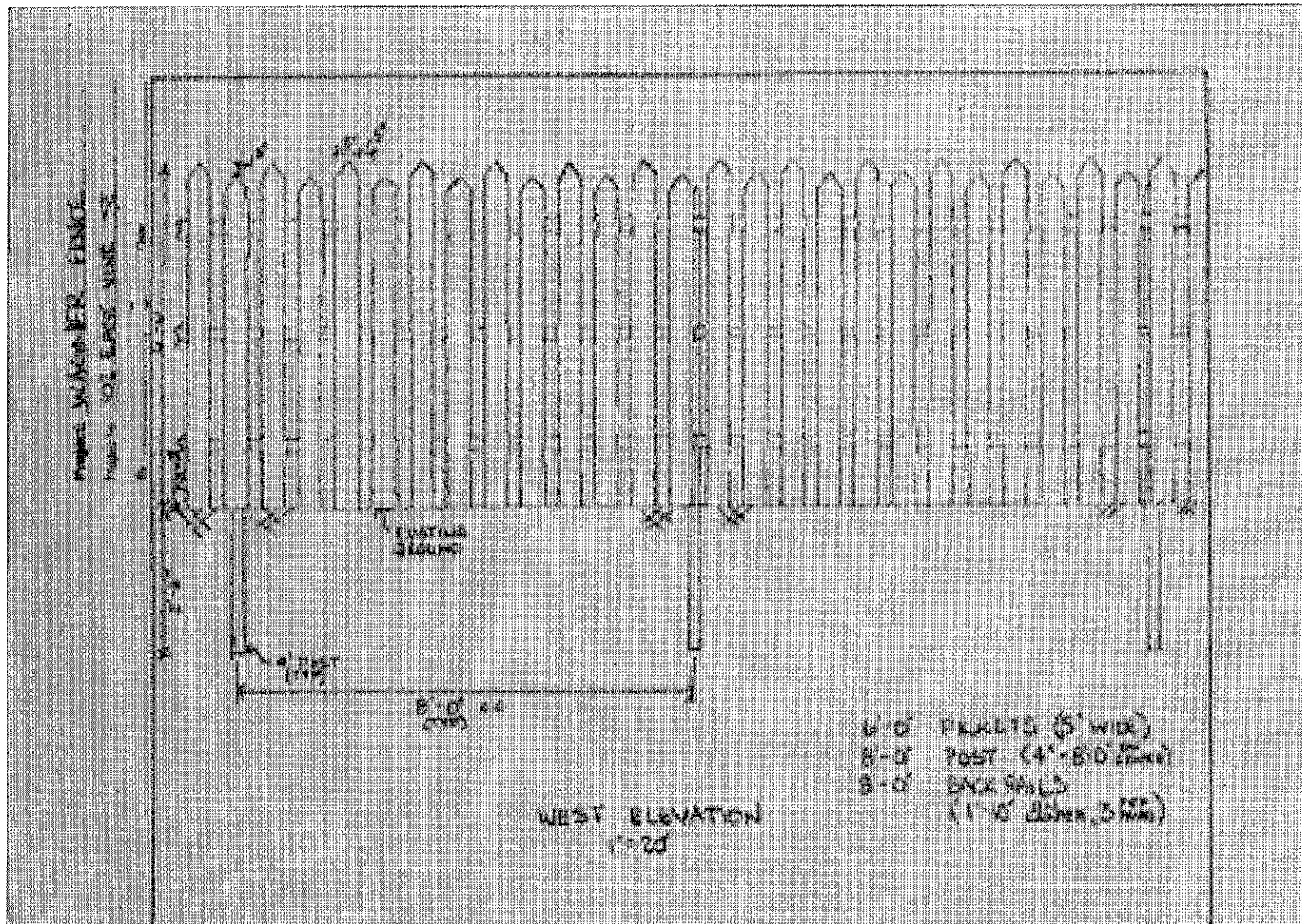
