Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie A. Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officer Tom Fischer. The claim is in the amount of \$385.00 for 3.50 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. A criminal investigation was initiated against the police officer on whose behalf this claim was filed, but they were ultimately not charged.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Wis. Stat. § 895.35, Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

The above-named police officer has retained us to represent him in connection with the above-referenced matter. Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent him, and as he was performing the duties of his office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on his behalf for the indicated legal fees. The MPD investigated whether PO Fischer drove a motor vehicle on duty after his driver's license was suspended.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officer initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When he requested counsel, IAD compelled PO Fischer to give a statement concerning the incident after issuing a PI-21. No charges were brought against the officer. Attached is a copy of a report from Cmdr. Settingsgaard of IAD and an itemization of the time and services rendered.
