Dear Mr. Singh:

This is to notify you that on Tuesday, September 6, 2016, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that the Class A Fermented Malt Beverage Retailer, Cigarette and Tobacco, and Food Dealer Retailer licenses be revoked for the premises located at 3100 N 27th St ("All Star Food") based upon the revocation complaint, unfit location, Health Department reports, and police and neighborhood testimony.

On September 9, 2016, you were mailed true and correct copies of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the revocation complaint for the Class A Fermented Malt Beverage Retailer, Cigarette and Tobacco, and Food Dealer Retailer licenses, in which the Committee recommended that the Class A Fermented Malt Beverage Retailer, Cigarette and Tobacco, and Food Dealer Retailer licenses be revoked. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Tuesday, September 20, 2016, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not appear, and you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Licenses Committee to revoke the Class A Fermented Malt Beverage Retailer, Cigarette and Tobacco, and Food Dealer Retailer licenses based upon the revocation complaint, unfit location, Health Department reports, and police and neighborhood testimony. The revocation is effective September 20, 2016.
