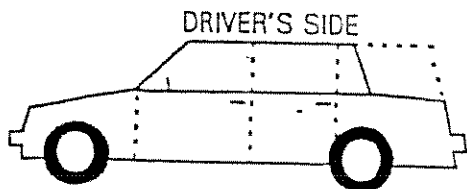

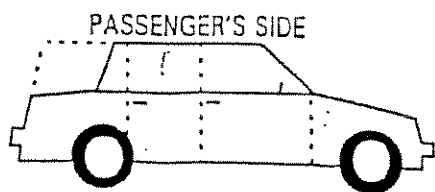

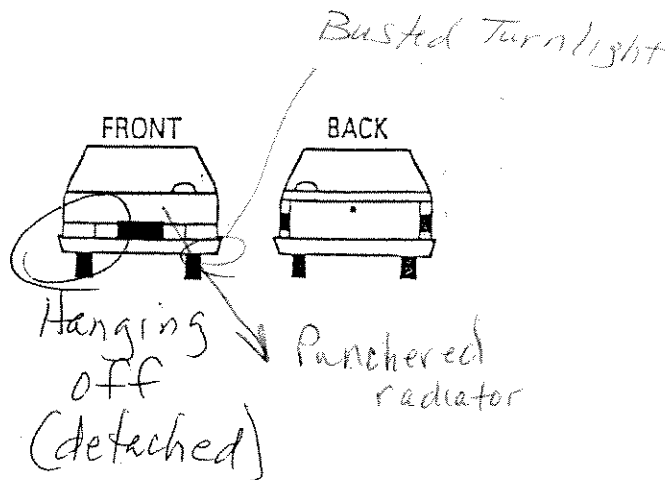
CIRCLE AREAS OF DAMAGES USING THE DIAGRAMS BELOW
