File #010401 is an ordinance relating to the fees charged for on-street daytime parking permits.

Background and Discussion

- 1. Section 101-27.5 of the City Code, Residential Daytime Parking Privilege for Nonconforming Residential Uses states:
 - Any person whose residence was erected prior to October 27, 1970, and which does not provide one parking space per dwelling unit may, after filing an application with the city clerk, obtain a special privilege parking permit authorizing the applicant to park one vehicle in excess of any posted time limits . . .
- 2. After review and verification of the application, a permit will be issued by the License Division of the City Clerk's Office.
- 3. Section 81-86 of the City Code, Parking Permit: On-Street Daytime Residential, specifies the fees. On March 30, 1973, the fees for on-street, daytime, residential parking were set, with the annual permit at \$2.00, and the quarterly permit at \$1.
- 4. This ordinance will increase the fees. The annual permit fee will be increased from the current \$2 to \$36 while the quarterly permit fee will be increased from \$1 to \$10.
- 5. The division indicates that for 2000, 1,030 annual permits were issued and 70 quarterly permits were issued, collecting \$2,130 in fees.

Fiscal Impact

1. The increase in fees for on-street daytime parking permits will result in approximately \$37,780, providing 1,030 annual permits and 70 quarterly permits are issued. This is an increase of \$35,650 in revenue.
