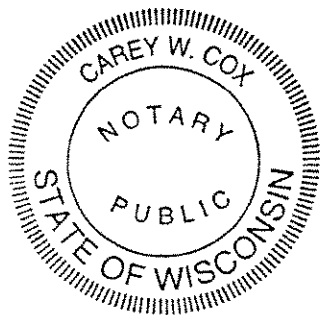

OFFICIAL NOTICE Published by Authority of the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee Office of the City Clerk

Notice is hereby given that an ordinance (passage of which is now pending) was introduced at the April 13, 2004 meeting of the Milwaukee Common Council, the essence of which is as follows:

Substitute ordinance to change the zoning from Industrial Light (IL) to Local Business (LB) on land located on the Northeast Corner of South 6th Street and West Layton Avenue, in the 13th Aldermanic District.

Resolved, That the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, do ordain as follows:

Part 1. There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances a new section to read as follows:

Section 295-60(2)0008. The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for the area bounded by the zoning line within the right-of-way along South 6th Street, the zoning line within the right-of-way of West Layton Avenue, a line 440 feet North and parallel to the north line of West Layton Avenue, a line 155.3 feet West and parallel to the north line of South 6th Street and a line 240 feet North and parallel to the north line of West Layton Avenue, from Industrial Light (IL) to Local Business (LB).

Notice is hereby further given that the foregoing matter will be given a public hearing by the Committee on Zoning, Neighborhoods and Development in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on Tuesday, June 8, 2004 at 9:00 A.M., pursuant to the provision of Sub-Section (7)(d) of Section 62.23 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.
