Good morning Ald. Murphy,

Regarding your request to identify how many overdose patients reside outside the City of Milwaukee, here is what we discovered by analyzing our computer automated dispatch (CAD) data and comparing it to our electronic patient care report data.

The time period that we used for information provided in this email was January 1st to November 9th 2017.

ZIP code info

- Of 2,909 overdose incidents, 38 were missing ZIP codes. (Most likely identified as homeless)
 - Of the remaining 2,871 overdose incidents:
 - 2,549 lived in Milwaukee
 - 281 lived outside Milwaukee, but in state
 - 41 lived outside of Wisconsin

I have also attached the following updated Overdose and Narcan data which may be useful information for the City-County Heroin, Opioid and Cocaine Task Force.

- **OD calls per area.xlsx**
 - This spreadsheet identifies each Fire Station in the MFD showing how many Overdose incidents and how often Narcan was administered in their boundary area (1st in response area).
 - They are listed in descending order of percentage of time Narcan was given for an overdose incident.
 - Station 26 (located on 26th & Scott on the south side) is at the top of the list with the most overdose calls and the most narcan administered.
- **od all calls.pdf**
 - This PDF document is a map showing the boundaries (1st in areas of response) of each fire station in Milwaukee.
 - Each black dot represents an incident that was either initially dispatched as an overdose or was found to be an overdose once the MFD arrived on scene.
 - We found that a few incidents had multiple patients at the same address.

- [od narcan.pdf](#)
 - This PDF document is also a map showing the boundaries (1st in areas of response) of each fire station in Milwaukee.
 - Each red dot represents an incident where narcan was administered to one or more patients.
 - NOTE: There are times when Narcan is given to rule out an opioid overdose. I.E. – unresponsive patient who has a normal blood sugar or who may have had a seizure. In these cases Narcan may be given with no improvement of patient responsiveness thus ruling out a possible opioid overdose.

In summary, our data shows that the most concentrated area of overdose and narcan administration is currently the near south side. Roughly bordering south of National, North of Cleveland, West of 1st and East of 27th

I realize that this is a lot of information for one email but I hope it helps in answering the questions you may have regarding the MFD's role in combating the opioid crisis.

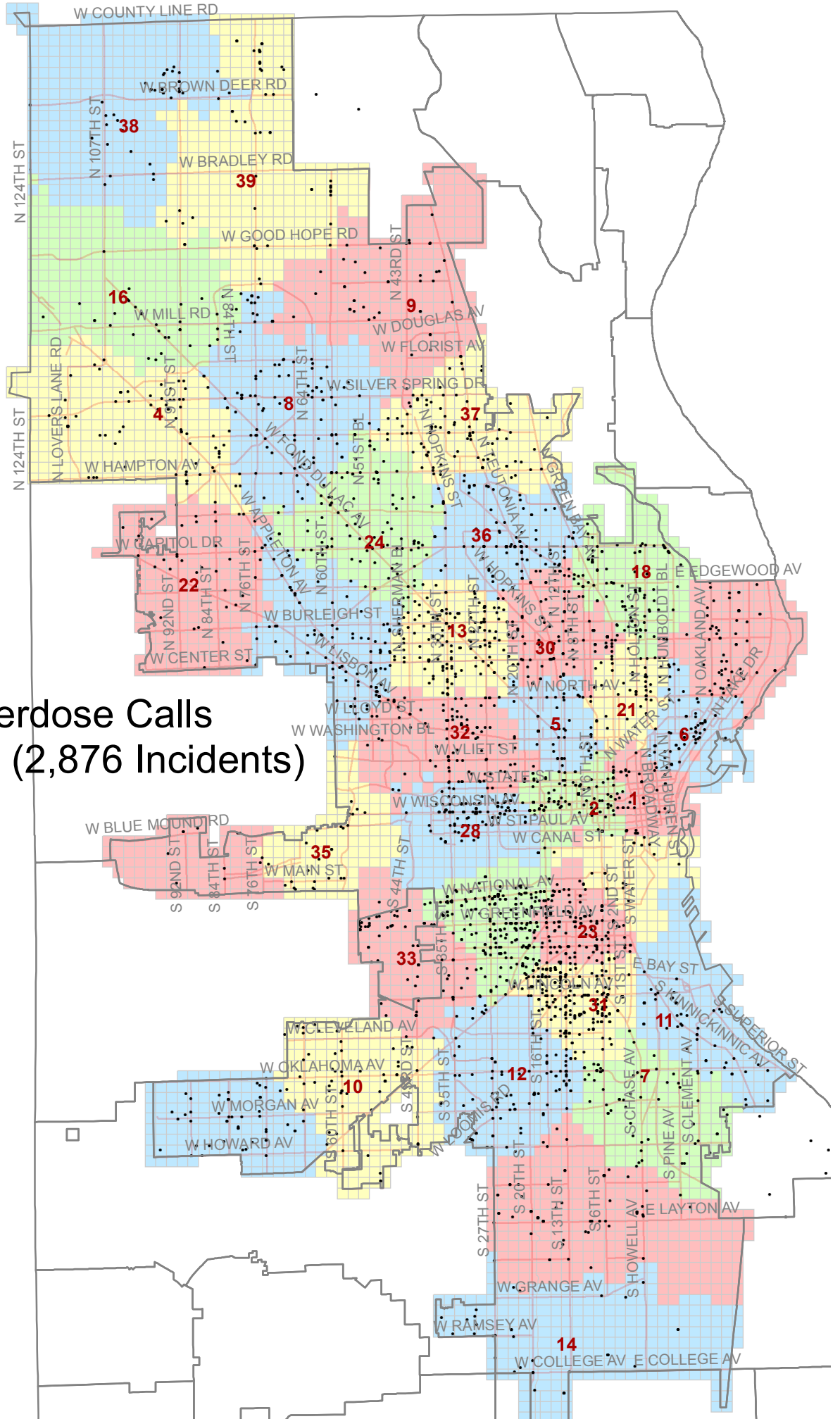

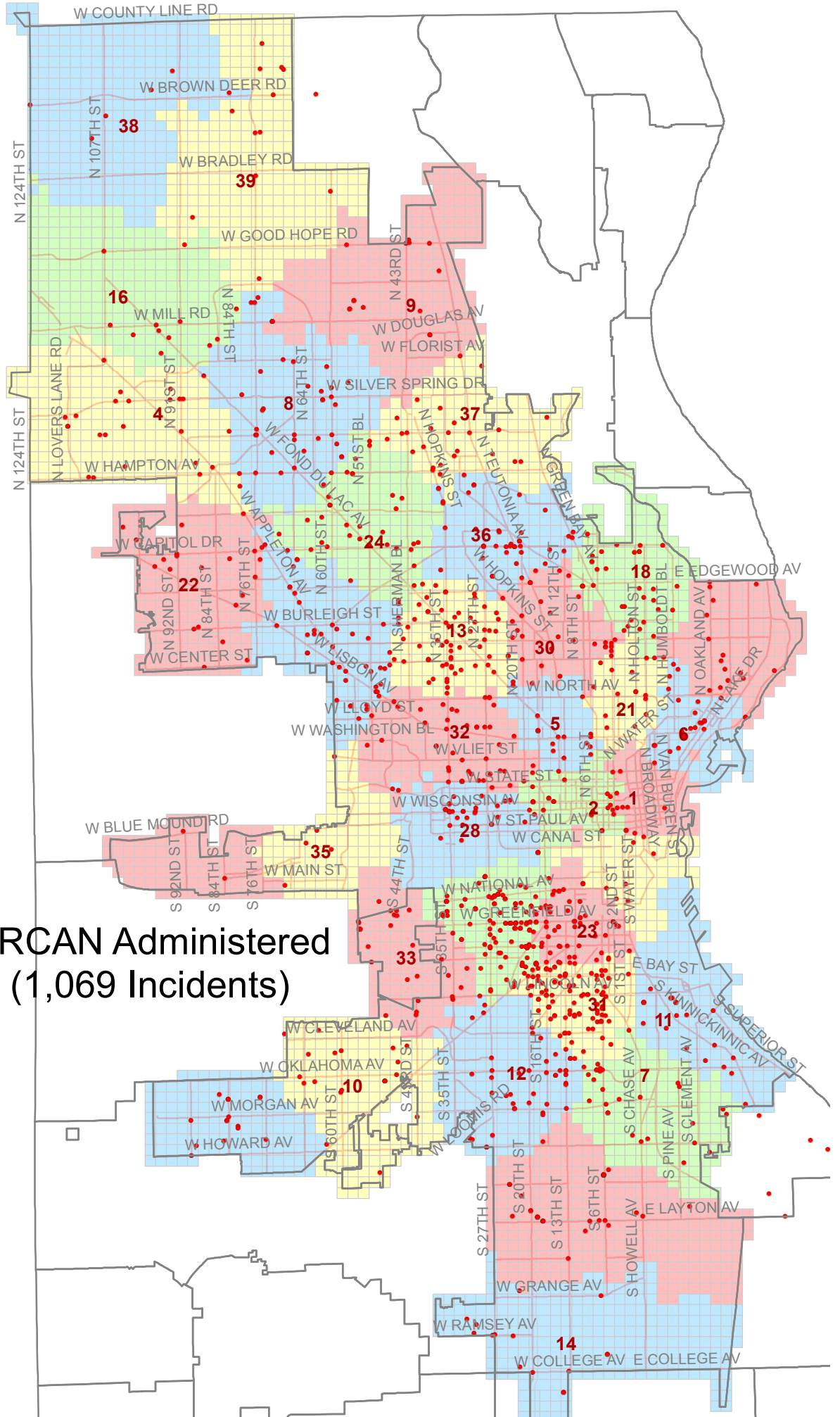
