Akil, will contact District Four, fo a walk through prior to opening. It was currently still set up like a restaurant. He stated this will be under full construction, once he has ownership of the building.




Concentration Map

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.



- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.





Assisting in this assignment was Tamesha A ROBERSON (b/f, 04/21/2002). ROBERSON is 17 years old and is not of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 10:06am ROBERSON entered the Tobacco Deal at 10400 W. Silver Spring Dr. She was able to purchase a Black and Mild cigar from the cashier for \$1.00. ROBERSON stated the clerk did ask for an ID but made the sale anyway. I entered the store and the described cashier was identified as Bhimsen THAPA (w/m, 09/19/1986). THAPA stated he did look at her ID but he seemed confused as to what year someone should be born in that would make them 18. I did observe the tobacco sale sticker on the counter by the register that stated anyone born after this date in 2001 was too young to buy tobacco products. I spoke with the agent, Imran GHAFFAR, by phone and advised him he would be receiving a citation for Sale of Cigarette to Minor/Underage. He stated that he has given THAPA training on when to make sales and has had him sign a form stating he understands.


