

Dear Mr. Calvey:

We have received your claim in the amount of \$2,481.91, relating to vehicle damage and injuries you allegedly suffered on August 7, 2007 when your vehicle struck an open manhole at North 8th Street and West Michigan Street.

Our investigation reveals that the Infrastructure Services Division reviewed their records and found that they responded to a report of a missing manhole cover at the location and on the date in question. They found that the manhole cover was for the Metropolitan Intercepting Sewer which is owned by the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District. The manhole was reseated on the manhole frame. Since your loss does not involve the City of Milwaukee, it cannot be held liable, as such, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the date of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
