File #051484 is a resolution extending the current Lease Agreement between the City of Milwaukee and the Milwaukee County Federated Library System for office space at Central Library.

## **Background and Discussion**

- 1. This resolution authorizes the lease agreement of 6,256 square feet of space at Central Library of Milwaukee Public Library (MPL) for an additional two years at \$115,000 annually, with the Milwaukee County Federated Library System (MCFLS).
- 2. MCFLS was established in 1973 to facilitate the orderly and efficient operation of cooperative public library services throughout Milwaukee County. MCFLS is state-funded and has 15 members, MPL has been a member of MCFLS since its formation.
- 3. Previous lease agreements between MCFLS and MPL have included:

Three year extension of lease from 2003 through 2005, at \$105,000 per year.

Two year extension of lease from 2001 through 2002, at \$102,500 per year.

Seven year lease, January 1, 1994 through December 31, 2000, a total of \$475,000 in payments.

- 4. The 1993 capital budget authorized an expenditure of \$146,000 for the construction of a computer room for MCFLS. During the renovations at Central, a sorting and computer room facilities was provided for MCFLS's online computer system.
- 5. MPL has a total of 5 agreements with MCFLS. They include:

## Fiscal Impact

- 1. The extension of the current Lease Agreement between the City of Milwaukee and the Milwaukee County Federated Library System for office space at Central Library will result in \$115,000 per year.
- 2. The lease agreement is extended from January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2007.
