## Dear Council Members:

The Marquette Interchange Reconstruction Project includes repair/construction of local streets impacted by the project bounded by North 13<sup>th</sup> Street, West Clybourn Street, West Saint Paul Avenue, and the Milwaukee River. The Federal Project provides cost participation for the improvement of traffic control devices in conjunction with the highway paving.

The total estimated cost of the project is \$32,872.99 and one hundred percent of the total cost will be funded by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT).

We have, therefore, prepared the attached resolution, which authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a Local Force Account (LFA) – State contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install and/or modify traffic control facilities in conjunction with the repair/construction of the Marquette Interchange impacted streets bounded by North 13<sup>th</sup> Street, West Clybourn Street, West Saint Paul Avenue and the Milwaukee River in the 4th Aldermanic District.
