
Dear Mr. Salvo, Atty. Halbrooks, and Atty. Lerner:

If you previously paid the license fees you are eligible for a refund, except for a \$75 administrative fee, by bringing in your receipt or filing an application for a refund within one year to date of Common Council action with the License Division, Room 105, City Hall.
