The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. 3. On 12/29/14 at 11:12 pm, Milwaukee police responded to 2624 W Lisbon Avenue for a Shotspotter that occurred at 1843 N 30th Street. Investigation revealed a vehicle left N 30th Street at a high rate of speed and entered the parking lot of 2624 W Lisbon. The driver exited the auto and walked into the store, despite officers ordering the driver to stay in the car. The subject then entered the gas station and officers observed the subject walk to one area of the store and shortly thereafter, exited and attempted to re-enter his car, when officers arrested him. An officer entered the store and could smell a strong odor of marijuana and based on his observations of where he last saw the subject at, walked over to that area and observed two clear plastic sandwich bags containing an off white chunky substance, suspected of cocaine, placed inside of a Munch peanut butter box. Police also viewed video surveillance of the incident. The substance tested positive for cocaine. The suspect was found to be in possession of \$4,263.50, that is consistent with that of street level sales.

6. On 12/29/2015 at 12:26am officers were dispatched to 2624 W. Lisbon Ave for a Shotspotter call. A call was also received from the business for shots fired. The applicant stated to officers a fight started by the door and he heard several shots outside. The applicant provided the officers with video of the incident. The video showed occupants of two different autos getting into an argument by the front door. One of the subjects runs back to his car and appears to be pointing something at the other auto. Nine casings were recovered in the area that subject was standing. All subjects fled prior to police arrival. Milwaukee Police Department report # 15-363-0008 was filed.

1. On 03/27/16 at 3:21 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2624 W Lisbon Avenue. Investigation revealed a subject inside the station had a gunshot wound to the right shoulder. The victim has entered the station to make a purchase and when exiting, the suspect came from behind the gas pumps and pointed a gun at the victim and fired from close range, striking the victim. Both subjects began to fight with the suspect fleeing from the area. The incident was caught on video surveillance. Officers were unable to make contact with the owner of the premise.
2. On 01/05/17 at 9:03 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 27th and Lisbon for a battery complaint. Upon arrival, police located the victim on the sidewalk in the 1800 block of N 27th Street. The victim suffered traumatic injuries to his head and despite lifesaving measures by MFD, the victim was pronounced deceased at the scene. Investigation revealed the victim was an employee at the Lisbon BP located at 2624 W Lisbon. Video surveillance captured the victim confronting the suspect as soon as the suspect entered the premise. It appeared that the victim ordered the suspect to leave the store. The suspect then grabbed several items from the premise and headed for the door. The victim and suspect engaged in a brief struggle, and the suspect broke free and ran west across N 27th Street. The victim, who was carrying a baseball bat, chased after the suspect. The two went out of camera range but came back into view and in the distance, the suspect could be seen striking the victim while he is on the ground. A witness observed the incident and provided a statement to police.

During this investigation, officers observed a suspected hand to hand drug transaction and conducted several field interviews. The clerk stated the subject was asked to leave several times. The subject refused to leave when the officer advised him to and he was arrested.
6. On 01/14/2018 at 2:08am officers were dispatched to a shotspotter call at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The investigation revealed a customer at the gas station bumped into another customer inside the store. As the customer was leaving the store several shots were fired at him from across the street. The nephew of the victim, who is a CCW permit holder, returned fire at the suspect. The suspect vehicle fled the scene. MPD report filed.

7. On 01/17/2018 1:56pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject call at 2624 W. Lisbon Av. The caller stated a known panhandle had been outside but had left just prior to the officer's arrival. The officers were not able to locate the subject.

18. On 12/29/18 at 8:30am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2624 W. Lisbon Avenue for a trouble with subject complaint. Upon arrival, officers interviewed the caller/employee who stated that a subject was panhandling. The area was searched for the subject but he could not be located.

Officers interviewed the victim who stated that an employee of the filling station "head butted" her and hit her multiple times with a baseball bat. The employee admitted to "head butting" her after she spit in his face and hit her with a bat after she threw around items inside the store. Surveillance video confirmed the altercation inside the establishment. Both parties were ordered into the District Attorney's office.
23. On 03/16/19 at 8:39am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2624 W. Lisbon Avenue for a disorderly conduct complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject entered the store and began smoking. When the clerk asked him to put the cigarette out, the subject blew smoke in the employees face. The subject entered a second time and caused a disturbance. The subject was located and arrested.
24. On 03/17/19 at 10:48am, Milwaukee Police observed a subject loitering in front of 2624 W. Lisbon Avenue. The subject was arrested.

At no time during the incident did the employees call 911 or the non-emergency number to report the incident.
36. On 09/14/19 a 17 year old working in conjunction with the Milwaukee Police Department and WI WINS Tobacco initiative, was able to purchase a 2 pack of Mango Swisher Sweet Cigars at 2624 W. Lisbon Avenue, The sales clerk admitted to selling the item and the applicant was issued a citation.

BEG stated that he has plans to expand the register area, to allow the clerks to identify problems sooner. He stated they have hired armed security from 7pm-3am but stopped it at the beginning of the pandemic. BEG stated he was looking into increasing outside lighting and outside cameras. The officers suggested increased signage advising no loitering. On 10/20/2020 the officers conducted a site visit. They found adequate outside lighting but the windows of the business were obstructed with merchandise signs preventing the clerks from seeing out. They also only observed one sign stating No Loitering.

BUTT stated he is a clerk at the convenience store/gas station. The female was still on scene when officers arrived and Positively identified by BUTT as the suspect in this offense. BUTT stated when he confronted WRIGHT to recover the merchandise, the female began to fight with him and caused a scratch on the right side of his face. BUTT stated this occurred on 09-12-2020 at 2624 W Lisbon Ave at approximately 12:56 pm. This is address is in the City and County of Milwaukee. BUTT stated this was done without his consent.

BUTT stated he has had contact with WRIGHT in the past and has known her to take items from the store without paying for them. BUTT stated he observed her pick up soda and candy bars and walk out the North door without paying for the items. BUTT stated he exited the store and stated to WRIGHT "hay put the stuff back". WRIGHT then threw the items on the ground. BUTT stated as he was picking up the items, WRIGHT was standing by him in a "fighting stance". This report was written by Police Officer Dorian WHITTENBERGER, assigned to District Three - Early Power Shift. I am assigned to the Community Prosecution Unit at District Three.

On Monday, October 19th, 2020 at approximately 12:00P, a meeting was conducted with the owner (Kalim M. BEG) and licensee (Aftab SULTAN, M/W, 09/18/66) of 2624 W Lisbon Ave, Lisbon BP. The meeting was scheduled to discuss the increase in violent crimes occurring at the property. At the meeting was myself, PO Michael JONES, Sergeant Guadalupe VELASQUEZ, ACA Heather HOUGH, ADA Jessica BALLENGER, Captain Steven JOHNSON.

During the meeting, it was discussed about the types of calls for service occurring at the location, focusing on the violent or drug related crimes (shooting, robberies, overdoses). When asked about the business' stance on the crime, the owner, BEG, discussed how the business receives well behaved neighborhood customers, but also will receive customers that create issues and nuisance problems. BEG described the community around the store is an issue for the store.

When asked what plans does the business have to abate the issues, BEG stated that there will be an expansion of the register area for the clerks. BEG stated this will give more visual area to cover by the clerks, which can help them notice problems sooner. BEG also stated that they will look into their plans and procedures (i.e, bathroom locked) to see what can be modified. BEG stated that they are open to improvements, but that the location of the store is difficult.

SULTAN stated that they had security at the beginning of Co-Vid, but that they quit once things started to shut down. SULTAN stated they have hired a person from the neighborhood (Gordy WILLIS) as armed security. SULTAN stated he believes WILLIS is licensed through the State of Wisconsin. SULTAN stated WILLIS' hours were 7P-3A.

BEG and SULTAN were notified that many of the violent crime issues happened during the after hour license. BEG stated that they are looking to increase lighting and outside cameras. Another suggestion was increasing signage. BEG and SULTAN were issued the District Three contact guide before departure.

On Wednesday, October 20th, 2020 at approximately 5:45P, PO HUDSON, PO RIVERA-HOLEY, and I, conducted a site visit of the location. During the time, the lights were on and were LED lights. There was adequate lighting on the property. There was only one small sign in the window in regards to loitering. There was no other signage indicating no loitering, no stopping for an unreasonable amount of time, no camera signs, no weapon signs. In the windows there was too much merchandise signage and bars, so the clerk is not visible to officers passing by. There is no visibility into the store itself, cannot see customers. There is a fenced garbage that was unlocked and readily area to hide. Another site visit will be conducted in the future to see if any improvements were made.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
