In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

All work will be done according to the descriptions, photos and specifications contained in this COA. A continuous ridge vent will be installed. The vent must extend along the entire length of the roof and must not stop short of the ends of the roof. No box vents will be installed on the roof. The chimney can be removed in this case because none of it is original to the building nor was constructed during the period of significance of the district. No other features of the building will be removed or altered including the dormer on the north elevation.

All work must be done in a crafts worker-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
