1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Good Morning Bob:

Last night when I was waiting for an eastbound bus on Wis. Ave. at the stop in front of Amalinda/The Box (315 E. Wisconsin) at 5 p.m., I was surprised to find a valet parking stand/podium on the sidewalk (close to the alley). The issue was not the stand, however, but the 5 orange traffic cones that the attendants had placed in the street, blocking a lane of traffic – 2 cones west of the alley and 3 east of the alley. This caused traffic congestion, horn-honking, unanticipated merging, and prevented buses from pulling up to the bus stop (my bus stopped out in the traffic lane). I don't believe there is even a loading zone there, but even if there is, it doesn't give the holder of the loading zone permit the right to put traffic cones in the street or to any kind of exclusive use of the zone.

By the way, it appeared that the valet parking service was serving The Box, because I saw a couple pull up to it, turn over their vehicle, and walk into The Box.

I hope you can get this issue rectified soon.





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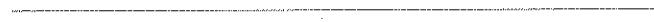

Dear Christopher White:

This letter serves as notice to you that Alfonso Morales, Chief of Police, by his designee, District 3 Commander, Jeffrey NORMAN, has determined that three (3) or more separate incidents of qualified activity have occurred at Family Dollar, a retail establishment located at 930 N 27th St, within a one-year time period. As the premises owner or other responsible party, you are required to install a security camera system and comply with all regulations set forth in Milwaukee Code of Ordinances (MCO) 105-91.

The qualified activities that have occurred at the premises include:

1. On Tuesday, December 5th, 2018 at 2:22PM, there was an armed robbery complaint at 930 N 27th St. The subject entered the location while armed, took property and pointed a firearm at the caller while fleeing from location. An incident report was taken under MPD IR# 17-339-0086.
2. On Sunday, March 4th, 2018 at 12:36PM, there was a shooting at 930 N 27th St. Subject fired shots at victim, causing injury. An incident report was taken under MPD IR# 18-063-0075.
3. On Sunday, July 29th, 2018 at 2:50PM, there was an armed robbery complaint at 930 N 27th St. Two subjects entered the location while armed, took property and fled from location. An incident report was taken under MPD IR# 18-210-0099.

The regulations of MCO 105-91 require you to install, maintain in proper working order, and operate during all hours the establishment is open to customers, security cameras that provide clear images of the entire premises, including areas as specified on the license as well as the public right-of-way abutting the premises and any off-street parking lot used expressly for patron parking. In addition, at least one security camera shall provide an overall view of each counter and register area, and at least one security camera shall be positioned to provide a clear, identifiable, full-frame image of the face of each person entering and leaving the retail establishment. Security camera views shall not be obstructed by fixtures or displays. If a time-lapse digital video recorder is operated, images shall not be recorded at a slower speed than 24 hours. All digital video records

shall be stored and maintained in good viewing order for 30 days after recording. On-duty store employees shall provide a copy of recorded digital images to law enforcement officers immediately upon request. The surveillance security cameras shall be maintained in proper working order for a period of 2 years from the date of this notice.

You must install a security camera system within sixty (60) days of receiving this notice. Any premises owner who violates any of the provisions of MCO 105-91 shall, upon conviction, forfeit not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000, and in default of payment thereof, be imprisoned as provided by law.


All installation work must be completed by a licensed electrical contractor. In accordance with MCO 200-24, permits are required except when the installation of wiring or equipment operates at less than 100 volts, unless any such installation is located in a plenum or it penetrates fire-rated or smoke-protected construction. Permit information may be found by calling (414) 286-2532.

Please be advised that you may appeal the determination of the Chief of Police to the Administrative Review Appeals Board as provided in MCO 320-11. The Board may extend installation beyond sixty (60) days in the case of a financial hardship. Any appeal must be in writing and a processing fee will be charged. Family Dollar Regional Manager, Kelly O'Dea attended the meeting, as well as Captain Jeffrey Norman, MPD CPU; Officer Corianna Cavazos, Officer Shannon Lambert and Sgt Ben Canniff, Beat Officer Matt Wenzel, ADA Catelin Ringersma and DNS Inspector Olgita David.

The following issues were discussed:

- Trainings being implemented for employees regarding how and when to contact the police.
- Providing the police department with contact information for each store location manager and Standard Operating Procedure plans.
- The sign and cement slab at the 930 N 27th St location that is being used as a seating area.
- A plan to address parking lot litter and garbage collection
- Efforts to address loitering and panhandling outside of the stores and in parking lot.

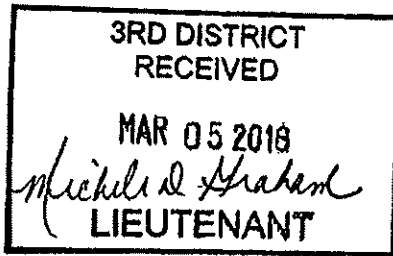

O'DEY stated that she was aware of the district three locations as being particularly challenging store locations. She stated that Family Dollar leadership was making strides to improve the locations. She stated that high employee turn-over was part of the difficulty in maintaining well-run store locations.

After discussing the issues, the group highlighted the following areas of concern:

- The need for training being implemented for employees regarding how and when to contact the police.
- Providing the police department with contact information for each store location manager and Standard Operating Procedure plans.
- The sign and cement slab at the 930 N 27th St location that is being used as a seating area.
- A plan to address parking lot litter and garbage collection
- Efforts to address loitering and panhandling outside of the stores and in parking lot.
- The current security guard employment (28 hours unarmed/ weekly) and whether or not this is sufficient.
- The Organized Retail Crime management position (whether or not you will be proceeding with this plan)
- Whether or not the new management team has been successful in enforcing the store standards and policies (such as parking lot and store cleanliness, monitoring cash counts and proper unloading of semi deliveries)
- Scheduling site visits and Crime Prevention through Environmental Design surveys at each location.

These items were brought to O'DEY as areas of concern that would require follow up. O'DEY stated she would work on addressing these items and committed to a follow up meeting to be set for the last week of October 2018 with an update on these items. She also stated she would bring the store managers to the next meeting so that they were all aware and on the same page about the plan of action.


