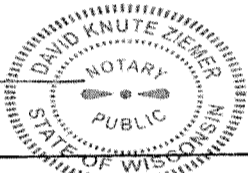

this purpose to the appropriate

projects do not involve any parcels  
of agricultural land which are eligible  
for deferred special assessments  
under the provisions of Section  
14.30 of the Milwaukee City Charter,
