Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 141667

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 141667, being a resolution to grant a special privilege to Educator's Credit Union to construct and maintain a concrete platform with step and handrails and two directional signs in the public right-of-way for the premises 6131 West Center Street.

The applicant constructed a new bank building at the subject premises and is requesting permission to construct and maintain a concrete platform with step and handrails to serve an emergency exit door on the west side of the building. The platform with step and handrails projects 2 feet into the east sidewalk area of North 62nd Street. A site visit revealed the presence of two directional signs located in the east sidewalk area of North 62nd Street. All of the aforementioned items are located behind the public sidewalk and do not interfere with pedestrian traffic.

We are not aware that the presence of said items will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow, formally, said items to occupy the public right-of-way.
