I was explaining why I had issues and one of the men reacted really badly to me telling him that the dog they left out all night over there kept me up all night a couple weeks ago. I'm not sure if you can hear, but he basically ended up called me a bitch several times, told me it was his property and he could leave a dog out whenever he wanted to, and told me he would make me move from the neighborhood (along with everyone else in the block watch). When I asked if he was threatening me, he said yes. This makes me afraid to show up to the next hearing regarding the car wash or anything else at that property. I've talked to a couple other neighbors, and while they are totally against the bar as well, they too are afraid to speak up against it. I did report this incident to the police.




City Concentration Map 7009 W Capitol Dr. Milwaukee


