Despite the beliefs and assumptions of the police officers involved ...it wasn't proven that my rental hit parked car(s) from my understanding the rental was involved in an accident which resulted from the avoidance of an oncoming radical driver. I'm being told that MPD officers were doing a "Wellness Check" that's the reason for them destroying my internal & external doors...If the allege driver of the rental drove from the accident to my residence and there is a witness; I would think that the driver being able to drive away and the witness seeing the driver should be valid reasons to verify that the allege driver was ok.


Allegedly it has been stated that the MPD officers attempted to get the attention of those who were in the residence of 2502 N. 46th St. Not one person in the residence heard MPD knocking on the door or ringing the doorbell. We were only aware of MPD officers presence once we heard MPD inside the residence yelling "MPD...is anyone home"

Reading your report there seems to be several items that are incorrect. The accident did not take place in the morning hours, there were not more than 2 cars involved. It was this writer who had to provide you (Investigator adjuster) with information about the occurrence because you were unable to locate a Sgt Washington and the accident report. How can you make a sound decision without having the proper documents, correspondence or information? How can you make a sound decision based off one's opinion? There is factual/tangible evidence that should be taken into consideration NOT opinions & assumptions. Then it was speculated that the driver of the rental car was intoxicated as you (investigator adjuster) mentioned to me via telephone; there is nothing to validate that assumption.

I think that MPD wrongfully entered my residence and should provide the funds necessary to make the two doors useable again. I appeal the decision that was made inadequately.

Dear Mr. Hall:

We are in receipt of your claim for damages to the front entry of your residence, 2502 N. 46th Street, which resulted from a forced entry by the Milwaukee Police Department on June 16, 2019.

We have conducted and concluded our investigation of this matter. Our investigation revealed that you were involved in a hit and run incident, striking parked vehicles in the vicinity Wright and Sherman during the morning hours on June 16, 2019. An independent witness notified police of your whereabouts, which was your residence, 2502 N. 46th Street.

When the police arrived at your home, and viewing the damages to your vehicle, they attempted to speak with you by knocking on the front and rear doors of your home, they did not get a response. The Sergeant in charge, viewing the damages of your vehicle, identifying your vehicle as being the at fault vehicle of the hit and run incident, and you not responding to police knocks on your front and rear door, a decision was made to proceed with a force entry into your residence to check on your welfare.

Our investigation concluded, that the Milwaukee Police Department conducted themselves according to standards and procedures set forth by the department. The City has no liability for the damages to your home from the June 16, 2019 incident. Therefore, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a written statement requesting a hearing within 21 days of the postmarked date of this letter to the


I am seeking repairs to both doors (exterior and interior) I do not have money in access to repair the doors myself. My doors are not able to be secured at the time.

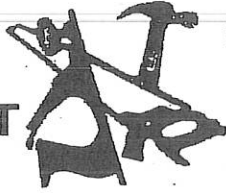
