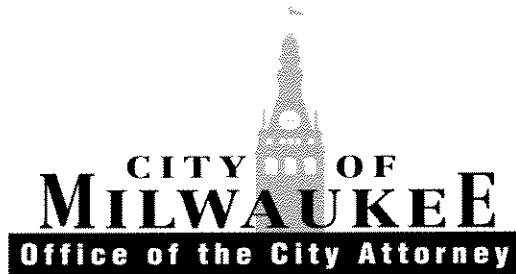

Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie A. Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officer Teresa Patrick. The claim is in the amount of \$649.00 for 5.90 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. A criminal investigation was initiated against the police officer on whose behalf this claim was filed, but they were ultimately not charged.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Wis. Stat. § 895.35, *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).


Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent her, and as she was performing the duties of her office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on her behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved the use of a taser during a traffic stop. The MPD conducted a criminal investigation and investigated the matter as a critical incident. Later, the DDA concluded that the Officers action was privileged. Attached is a copy of DDA White's letter and an itemization of the time and services rendered.

Dear Chief Hegerty:

On July 13, 2004, City of Milwaukee Police Officer Teresa Patrick fired her taser weapon and injured Homer Nero White. This occurred in the vicinity of the 3900 block of North Holton Street, City of Milwaukee. Officer Patrick with her partner had stopped the vehicle in which Mr. White was riding. Mr. White approached the officers, gesturing and speaking unintelligibly. Mr. White also refused several commands to show the officers his hands after placing them behind his back. He approached the officers and was within 9-12 feet of them when Officer Patrick discharged the taser. Mr. White was injured when his head struck the pavement after he was struck by the taser. He spent several days in the hospital for a head injury resulting from falling to the pavement. He has since been released.

Based upon the circumstances surrounding Officer Patrick's use of her taser, her actions were privileged in the exercise of self-defense under §939.48 of the Wisconsin Statutes.


