Pursuant to Section 893.80, WI Stats., I provide this Notice of Claim to the City of Milwaukee for ongoing damages to my home related to its supervision and inspection of a Neighborhood Improvement Project (NIP) on my home at 3750 N. 42<sup>nd</sup> Street, conducted by YMCA contractor Generon Construction, LLC.

## CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE CLAIM

On July 26, 2004, I was approved for a City of Milwaukee HOME Program fund in the amount of \$27,411.00. Beginning in July 2004 through January 2005, the Department of

Neighborhood Services (DNS) by Tom Mishefske and Maria Pellerin signed off on maintenance, electrical, plumbing, construction and revised construction scopes for work to be completed on my home under a NIP. On July 27, 2005, Tom Mishefske, NIP Program Manager informed me in a letter that as of July 25, 2005, YMCA contractor Generon had repaired my roof/eave for the last time, but that NIP would warrant the work for a period of one year after the completion date of July 26, 2005. The work on my home was either not finished or not completed in a competent manner and the City and its agents did not properly supervise/inspect this work.

## RELIEF SOUGHT

Reimbursement for damages caused by the improper/negligent supervision and inspection of work done on my property, including, but not limited to the following:

Cost of estimate to repair work by Generon (awaiting estimate from 274//);

Cost to hire another contractor, including labor and materials, to finish work not completed or completed in a negligent manner by Generon (including, but not limited to roof-related damages, removal of paint on living room floor, damage to bathroom vanity and door, damage to kitchen counter tiles) – approximately \$2744.

Costs to replace food stolen from my refrigerator by contractor's employees totaling approximately \$\sums\_5.

Cost to purchase new locks and keys for my home due to Generon's providing copies of my keys to all workers: \$\sum\_{150,00}

Other reimbursement, payment or recovery that may arise in the future and be deemed fair and appropriate.
