





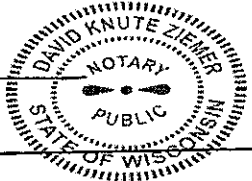

Concrete pavement reconstruction,
replace all curb and gutter, sidewalk

and driveway approaches, tree
removal where necessary, sodding
(6 - 15-foot width tree border area),
and grading.

Grantor Non-Reimbursable Paving
Fund - \$1,465,043

Grantor Reimbursable Paving
Fund - \$219,757

City Share - Non-assessable
Paving Fund - \$1,043,605

City Share - Assessable Paving
Fund - \$20,000
