6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

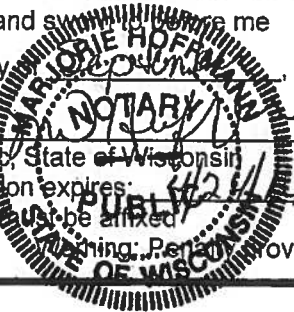

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

This supplementary report is written by P.O. Laurel Lammers, assigned to District Five, early shift; as the Community Liaison Officer. On Wednesday, December 17th, 2014 at 11:00 am, I met with Karen Bell regarding her application for a new liquor license for 735 E. Center St., which will be opened under the name of Company Brewing.

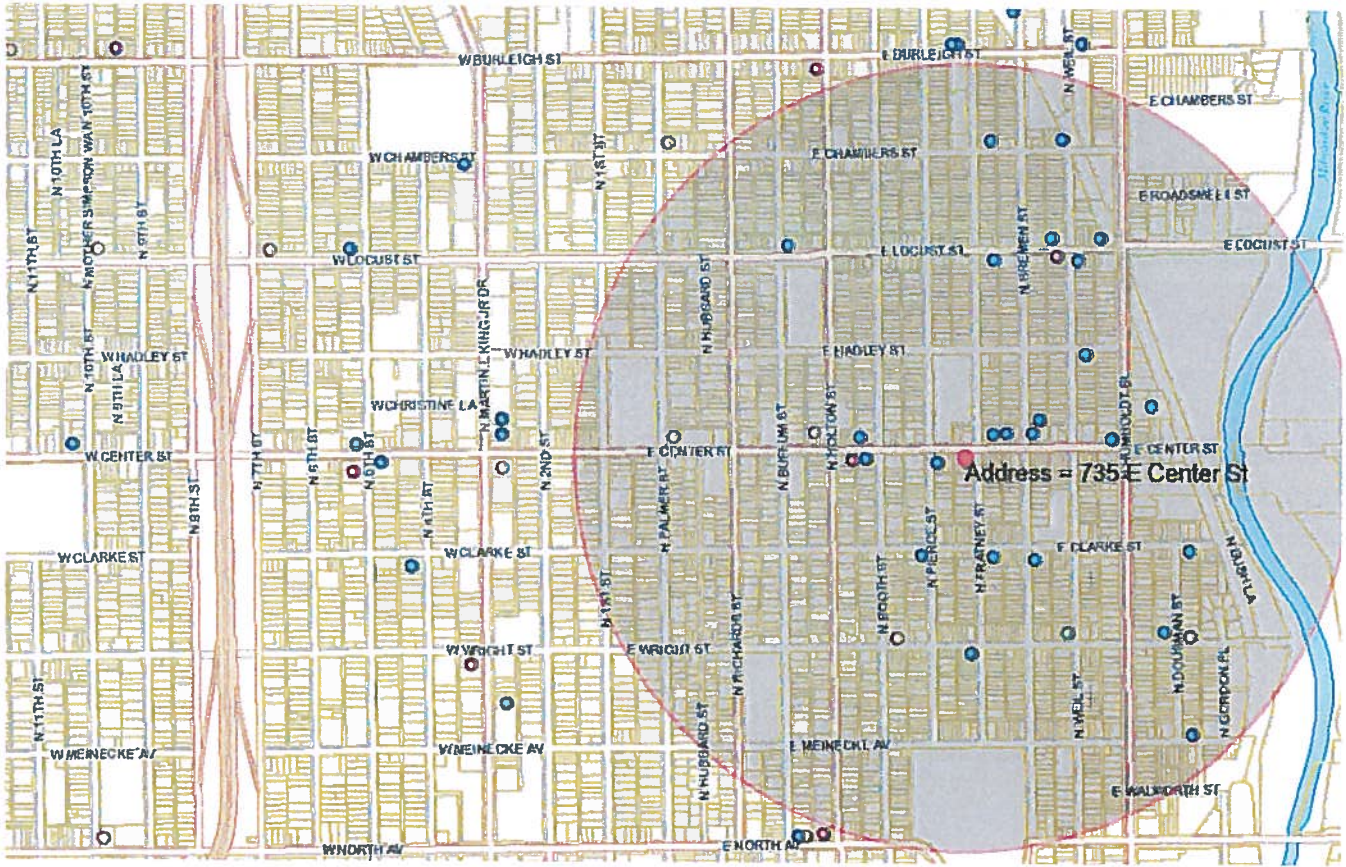
The proposed business is located on the south side of East Center Street, just west of North Fratney Street. The building is zoned for mixed use, commercial. The commercial tavern will occupy the lower portion of the building. Bell stated that they are also leasing the upper commercial space and plan to use that as an artist's space in the future. The main entrance to the tavern is on the north side of the building facing out towards East Center Street. The remainder of the lower portion of the building is all window space, allowing for complete visibility in and out of the business. Also, all along the north face of the building are placed multiple lights to light up the front of the business after hours of darkness. Surrounding the proposed business, are other businesses and stores, as well as residential homes.

The interior of the location is currently being renovated. Bell stated that there were some interior cameras but that they currently are not functional. There are no exterior cameras at this time. I did speak with Bell about the City of Milwaukee Surveillance Camera program.

Bell stated that she intends to open the business in late February, early March if possible. She plans on being open seven days a week, operating a tavern and a restaurant, from 11 am - close, each day. Current approved occupancy is 150. Bell stated that there would be approximately 10 employees at the location at all times.

I also explained the District Five standing complaint form program to Bell; however she chose not to participate at this time.
