There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings during normal business hours is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of Kilbourn Avenue and Water Street. You must present a copy of the meeting notice to the parking cashier.

Our main concern and question:

Does this property have ample parking to accommodate its patron's on a Friday and Saturday evening?

has been in business for 53 years and at our present location for 38 years. From past experience, especially with restaurant or entertainment type, we have had the overflow of other patron's using our lot when there was not ample parking at the businesses they were frequenting. During those times, we have experienced broken windows on our building and vandalism to our automobiles that have been parked outside for the weekend.

We do have surveillance cameras that monitor our business, including the parking lot and street activity. It is important for you to know that if our lot is used by someone else other than our customers vehicles, there will be a fee of \$100 a month.

This is a large concern for us.

- 4. On 02/18/23 at 10:25p.m., officers were dispatched to an Overdose at 4923 W. Villard Av. On arrival officers were advised by security the patron suffered from a seizure not an overdose, and they refused medical treatment by the ambulance.
- 5. On 03/28/23 at 1:42p.m., officers were dispatched to the area of N. 49th St., and W. Villard Ave., for a Shots Fired call. Officers observed a group of people assisting what appeared to be an intoxicated patron from the bar located at 4923 W. Villard Av. At no time during the investigation did any one flag officers down or appear in distress. A short time later, a victim of a shooting arrived at a hospital in the same vehicle officers observed earlier. Officers interviewed a gas station clerk from across the street as well as a resident from above the bar, both stated they heard the gun shots. Officers returned to the bar to investigate, however, it was closed.

- 6. On 05/17/23 at 3:12a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W. Villard Ave. On arrival the business was closed and no loud music could be heard. The officers contacted the caller who stated the music began at 11p.m., and continued until 1:30a.m. The caller further stated this does not occur daily and they think it depends on the DJ.
- 7. On 06/21/23 at 1:32a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W. Villard Ave. The caller stated they were willing to be a complainant and the music had been going on over 2 hours. On arrival the business was closed for and no loud music could be heard.
 - 8. On 07/02/23 at 12:52a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shots Fired at 4923 W. Villard Ave. On arrival officers made contact with citizens outside who stated they did not hear any shots fired, but there had been fireworks in the area.
 - 9. On 08/12/23 at 12:43a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Nuisance at 4923 W. Villard Ave. On arrival it was determined the music was loud, due to the door being held open while allowing patrons in. The security guard was advised to keep the door closed to avoid the disturbance. The security guard agreed. The officer was not able to make contact with the caller.
 - 10. On 08/17/23 at 4:26a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Nuisance at 4923 W. Villard Ave. Due to higher priorities calls for service the officers were not dispatched until after bar close. The officers contacted the caller who stated they no longer needed the police.
 - 11. On 10/12/23 at 5:42a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Nuisance at 4923 W. Villard Ave. On arrival there was no loud music and the business was closed.
 - 12. On 10/15/23 at 5:17a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W. Villard Ave. On arrival there was no loud music and the business was closed. The caller advised the officer the music had dissipated.
- 13. On 10/20/23 at 2:19a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W. Villard Ave. On arrival officers observed the business was closed and did not hear any loud music. The caller stated this was an ongoing issue and was willing to be a complainant, however, the officer was unable to make contact with them.

- 14.On 10/27/23 at 12:58a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W. Villard Ave. On arrival officers did not hear any music or noise that would constitute the necessity to approach the business.
- 15. On 10/28/23 at 12:21a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at 4923 W. Villard Ave. Officers interviewed the agent who was on scene that stated patrons who were about to fight inside the establishment and were escorted out. The agent assisted the officer in checking the interior of the bar to make sure no one was hurt.
- 16. On 11/08/2023, at 5:16a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W. Villard Ave. Due to higher priority calls for service, the officers arrived over 4 hours later and the business was closed.
- 17.On 11/10/23 at 12:13a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at 4923 W. Villard Ave. Officers were advised prior to arrival the caller stated a subject came to the bar with a rifle and threatened to shoot a named security guard. On arrival officers observed no one in distress and investigation revealed there was no security guard by the name provided employed at the business.
- 18.On 11/21/23 at 10:29p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 4923 W. Villard Ave. On arrival officers observed the business functioning normal. The anonymous caller stated they did not see anything and the call was placed two hours prior to officer's arrival.
- 19. On 12/01/23 at 11:25p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W. Villard Ave. Investigation revealed that when the business door was open, the music did appear to be excessively loud which could cause a disturbance to neighbors. Officers advised an employee of the violation, to which they agreed to turn the music down. The caller stated this occurs frequently and has affected them to the point they have considered moving.
- 20.On 12/13/23 at 2:15a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W. Villard Ave. No loud music was observed on officer's arrival and the business was closed.
- 21.On 11/30/23 at 11:52., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at 4923 W. Villard Ave. Officers interviewed the agent who was on scene. The agent stated two groups of patrons began to argue in the bar and were kicked out. One of the groups waited for the other group at the gas station and began to argue in the median with the other group. The agent further stated they were told a female had been knocked over by a vehicle and a parked vehicle was struck by a vehicle the subjects were in. The agent attempted to show officers video surveillance of the incident but was unable to retrieve the incident on the camera.
- 22. On 12/16/23 at 4:51a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W. Villard Ave. The original call came in at 2:09a.m. On arrival the business was closed, however, officers noted during routine patrol that night they had driven in the area and did not hear music coming from the bar itself, but possible patrons playing loud music from vehicles as they were coming and going.
- 23.On 12/31/23 at 1:09a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting at 4923 W. Villard Ave. On arrival officers did locate a victim shot to both legs, lying behind the bar. Investigation revealed the shooting occurred in the parking lot and the suspect was a security guard who did not remain on scene. The agent confirmed the suspect was an employee, however, denied knowing their name. The agent did allow officers to view video surveillance which depicted a

security guard discharge their weapon. The video depicts all the security guards to be armed, however, when officers arrived on scene, none were armed and some were uncooperative.

- 24. On 12/31/23, Milwaukee Police drafted a Nuisance Premise for 4923 W. Villard Ave. The officer noted that during the past year the business has had two critical incidents that involved shootings. The notice was signed by the District Captain and sent out via certified mail on January 1, 2024.
- 25.On 01/06/24 at 1:18a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shot Spotter at 4923 W. Villard Ave. Officers located two unspent casings on the Eastbound sidewalk in front of the location and one in the eastbound parking lane on W. Villard Ave. Officers observed multiple armed security guards and attempted to interview one, who refused stating they had to escort a patron to their car. Due to previous knowledge of the security system, officers knew video of the incident would not have been captured.
- 26.On 01/06/24 at 1:18a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W. Villard Ave. Due to a Shot Spotter call for service at a different location, officers did not respond until 5:07a.m., at which time the business was closed.
- 27.On 01/24/24 at 10:26p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W. Villard Ave. On arrival officers did not hear loud music, however, contacted the caller who stated they could feel the vibration, but not the music.
- 28.On 01/30/24 at 10:31p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 4923 W. Villard Ave. Officers observed the crowd to be small and 3 security guards on scene. The agent was on scene and the noise complaints were discussed. The agent stated they have asked security staff to get people to move out of the parking lot after close to keep the music down.
- 29. On 02/08/24 at 11:26p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 4923 W Villard Ave. There was no loud music coming from the location and officers were unable to contact the caller.
- 30. On 02/15/24, the applicant was charged with Operate Firearm While Intoxicated; Criminal Damage to Property (Domestic Abuse) and Disorderly Conduct (Use of a Dangerous Weapon) in Milwaukee County Circuit Court.




City Concentration Map 4923 W VILLARD AVE Milwaukee

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.




