There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Pl. They conducted follow up at The Citgo, 3114 N. Sherman Blvd which is next door. The employees where helpful in retrieving the surveillance footage and able to successfully download the video and use it as evidence.

2. On 03/27/20 at 9:00am, Milwaukee Police conducted a burglary investigation at 3106 N 42nd

3. On 08/16/20 at 2:48am, Milwaukee Police were conducting an investigation at 4200 W. Burleigh Street when they heard gunshots coming from the parking lot at 3114 N. Sherman Blvd. When officers went to investigate the incident, they did not find anyone injured or

property damaged, but found 2 casings in the parking lot of the filling station. Officers reviewed the video surveillance but found nothing of evidentiary value.

4. On 10/02/20 at 7:17am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3114 N. Sherman Blvd for an accident complaint. Investigation revealed that a vehicle struck one of the pumps while backing out of a parking space. The actor stayed on scene and a report was filed.

- 5. On 08/14/21 at 11:30pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3114 N. Sherman Blvd for a shots spotter complaint. Officers reviewed camera footage, which revealed two male subjects in a physical altercation prior to the shots being fired. The footage had technical difficulties and was not reviewed in its entirely. The business was not fully cooperative and did not want to provide officers with the clerk that was on duty at the time of the incident. Officers downloaded the video from the hard drive; the video was placed on police inventory. No casing were located near the location.
- 6. On 08/30/21 at 10:06am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3114 N. Sherman Blvd, for a violation of restraining order complaint. The agent stated that a known suspect was on his property and attempted to buy groceries. The suspect was denied and told to leave the location. The suspect remained at the location and moved the outside garbage can around the location. The agent stated that the incident was captured on video, but the agent was unable to get play back. Officers provided the agent with department email and stated that the video could be emailed. Officers confirmed the restraining order is valid and checked for the suspect but was unable to locate the suspect. The suspect frequents the business and had a prior offense for violating the restraining order. Officers are pending the case and will have the incident reviewed at the District Attorney's office.
- 7. On 09/06/21 at 8:33am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3114 N. Sherman Blvd, for theft complaint. The victim stated that an unknown suspect reached in to her purse and took money while she was paying for items at the counter. The suspect then fled the location on foot. The business was cooperative and provided video to the officers of the incident.
- 8. On 10/31/2021 officers were dispatched to a Suspicious Person at Sherman and Burleigh. The officer contacted the caller by phone and she stated she was at the gas station and a subject approached her auto stating he was an undercover police officer. The subject refused to identify himself and the female drove off. The officer contacted the employees of the gas station at 3114 N. Sherman BI but they could not access the video. On 11/01/2022 the officer conducted follow up and was able to view the video.
 - 9. On 05/06/23 at 9:43pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3114 N. Sherman Bl., for a fight complaint. Officers spoke with the caller who was the store clerk. The store clerk stated subjects were fighting in the location at 9:30pm. Officers reviewed video of the incident. The business was cooperative with the investigation.
 - 10. On 05/18/23 at 3:00pm, Milwaukee Police conducted follow up at 3114 N. Sherman Bl, regarding a reckless use of weapon investigation. Officers spoke with the employee and requested video footage from earlier in the day, where subjects were being struck by paint

- balls. The employee was cooperative with officers and provided video evidence, which subsequently lead to the arrest of the suspect.
- 11. On 06/17/23 at 9:35pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3114 N. Sherman Bl., for an armed robbery complaint. Officers spoke with the store clerk who stated that 7-8 subjects entered the store and took items without paying for them. The clerk attempted to make his way to the door before the suspects left. One of the suspects then made threats that he had a gun and will shoot the clerk. The clerk provided video of the incident to officers for the investigation.
- 12. On 06/20/23 at 11:25pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3114 N. Sherman Bl., for an armed robbery complaint. Officer spoke with employee who stated multiple suspects came in the business and took items without paying for them. One of the suspects then displayed a hand gun pointing it at the employee during the incident. The business was cooperative with the investigation and provided video of the incident.
- 13. On 07/02/23 at 10:09pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3114 N. Sherman Bl, for a shoplifter complaint. Officers spoke with the employee who stated that 15-20 juvenile suspects came to the location and took various store items without paying for them. Officers reviewed the video of the incident. The employee stated that they been having similar thefts during the week. The clerk stated that the juveniles would get kicked out of the nearby park then come to the location to steal. Officers advised the clerk to close the doors to the business around 10:00pm, to attempt to curve the thefts.
- 14. On 09/12/23 at 1:04am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3114 N. Sherman Bl, for susp. person/auto complaint. Officers arrived at the location and the business was closed. Officers located a subject on top the roof of the gas station. Officers ordered the suspect off the roof, who then jumped off and fled the location on foot. Officers gave a brief chase and took the suspect in to custody. Officers made contact with the business agent, who was cooperative with the investigation, and provided video.

On Thursday May 18, 2023, at approximately 3:00PM P.O. Johnathan SCHROEDER and I were dispatched to 3114 N Sherman BL. which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee WI, in attempt to locate video regarding our reckless use of a weapon investigation.

Upon arrival we spoke with the manager identified as Mandeep SINGH (I/M, 04/08/1999. I explained the reason for my presence at his store and requested to watch video footage from today's date in an attempt to locate any footage of an incident of subjects being struck with paintballs which is alleged to have taken place there earlier in the day.

SINGH was very helpful and cooperative with the investigation, providing immediate access to his video recording system. This cooperation allowed us to recover vital video footage regarding a violent act, leading to helping secure an arrest later in the day.

On Saturday June 17th, 2023, at 9:35 P.M, Squad 7430 (PO Juliana NAILEN and I) were dispatched to a Armed Robbery complaint to the address of 3114 N Sherman Blvd (Citgo Gas Station), which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Upon arrival I was met by my caller who verbally identified himself as Amandeep SINGH (A/M 09-24-2002). SINGH he is the store clerk at this Citgo gas station. SINGH stated seven to eight black males entered the store and started to take items from the store. SINGH stated he recognized them from previous times. SINGH stated the males stole items from the store without paying. SINGH stated that today they were taking a box of Honey Buns, a box of Gushers and an assortment of candy and soda. SINGH stated at the time that he was behind the counter and was making his way to the door to confront them. SINGH stated that the male with the blue ski mask looked at him and said, "I got a gun, if you come outside, I am going to shoot you". SINGH stated the male with the blue ski mask had his hand in his hoodie when he made the threatening statement. SINGH stated he could see a bulge in his hoodie. SINGH stated he did not go outside and called the police.

SINGH stated he did not know the exact amount of money the property was worth at the time.

My partner PO NAILEN was viewing surveillance footage at the time this incident notification was completed.

On Tuesday, June 20th, 2023, at 11:25 pm, I was dispatched to 3114 N Sherman Blvd, along with my partner (PO Chandler GAYAN) for an Armed Robbery.

Upon my/our arrival I observed, the Citgo gas station with the lights off and doors locked with three employees standing inside the gas station

I spoke to the business owner and victim of the incident Pakhar SINGH. SINGH stated, multiple males and females barged into the store and started stealing honey buns, chips, and miscellaneous candy. SINGH tried getting them out of the store when an unidentified subject B/M, approximately 16-20 years of age, wearing a black sweatshirt and blue jeans pointed a firearm at him, telling him to chill, simultaneously the large group of individuals kept stealing items out of his business.

Squad 9369 Detective Matthew BONGELL, and Squad 9390 Detective Maxwell OURS, spoke to the two witnesses who were employees working at the time of the armed robbery.

The owner of the business and victim of the incident Pakhar SINGH was very cooperative with the investigation. SINGH showed responding Officer's video of the entire incident and answered all questions he was asked.

I reviewed video surveillance footage. The footage showed what SINGH stated had occurred, I saw the individual matching the description with a black handgun, pointing it at SINGH.

On Sunday July 2nd, 2023, I was assigned to Squad 7451 with P.O. Sarah DELEON. We were wearing a full Milwaukee Police Officer uniform which included our department issued badges and body worn cameras.

At approximately 10:09 PM we were dispatched to the address of 3114 N. Sherman BI (Citgo Gas Station), which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI for Shoplifter.

Upon arrival I and P.O. DELEON spoke with the caller who was verbally identified as Amandeep SINGH (A/M, 9/29/2002). SINGH stated prior to our arrival approximately 15-20 juvenile subjects entered the gas station and grabbed various snacks. SINGH showed me surveillance where I observed at least 15 subjects entering the gas station all at once. The subjects are seen running inside and grabbing snacks before exiting the gas station. I also observed subjects sitting on the front counter recording on cellphones and dancing.

SINGH stated this has been and everyday situation for the last couple of weeks. I advised SINGH that a huge crowd of juveniles are hanging out at Sherman Park. I advised SINGH that Milwaukee County Sherriff's Department closes the park at 10pm. SINGH stated every time the juveniles get kicked out of Sherman Park the subjects come into the gas station. I advised SINGH it will probably be beneficial if he closes the door to the gas station store at 10:00pm to stop the subjects from coming into the gas station.

SINGH was given a community contact card.

Upon arrival, we observed an individual matching the CAD broadcasted suspect description (male, dark clothing, hat) on the roof of the closed Citgo gas station (3114 North Sherman Boulevard). This suspect was identified as Romero L. DORSEY (B/M, 01-16-1980). We gave legal, lawful, verbal commands to DORSEY while he was at gunpoint to show us his hands. DORSEY then proceeded to jump from the roof of the gas station and attempted to flee on foot southbound into Sherman Park, from uniformed officers giving these legal and lawful commands. We engaged in a foot pursuit with DORSEY while calling for backup squads and broadcasting DORSEY's description and flight path. 
