
This is to notify you that on Wednesday, May 15, 2019, the City's Public Works Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council nonrenewal of your Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license, based upon nonappearance and your police report.

On May 16, 2019, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Public Works Committee with respect to the renewal application for your Public Passenger Vehicle license in which the Committee recommended that the license not be renewed. You were further notified that the Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Wednesday, May 29, 2019 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not appear, and you did not file written objections to the report of the Public Works Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Public Works Committee, the Common Council voted to not renew your Public Passenger license based on nonappearance, and the police report.

If you previously paid the license fees you may be eligible for a refund, except for a portion of the fee that may be retained, by bringing in the receipt or filing an application for a refund within one year to date of Common Council action with the License Division, Room 105, City Hall.
