

did arrive on the scene operated by P.O. Michelle ANGIOLO. Mr. HOOGLAND reports that due to his large build he had difficulty getting into the police wagon. He states at this time either one or both of the female officers assisted him into the wagon by pushing on his hands. He states that his hands were handcuffed behind his back and the pressure applied to his hands resulted in the injury to his right hand.

During an interview with HOOGLAND he declined to make further statements to further this investigation. He also stated that he had no knowledge why he was being questioned regarding his injury and that at no time did he make the complaint regarding the officers behavior. Upon interview with Dr. Dennis ANDERSON, the physician who treated Mr. HOOGLAND'S injury, he reported that the injury suffered by Mr. HOOGLAND was not consistent to his account relative to the officers pushing him into the patrol wagon. Dr. ANDERSON continued stating that Mr. HOOGLAND'S injuries are more consistent to what he referred to as a "boxers fracture". He explained that this type of injury occurs when someone punches an object very hard.

CONCLUSION:

Due to the complainants apparent lack of cooperation to further this investigation and Dr. ANDERSON'S diagnosis that the injury wasn't consistent to the account provided by the complainant, this incident will be cleared as baseless.
