Dear Chief Jones:

On August 31, 1997, City of Milwaukee Police Officer Derrick Harris fired one round from his service revolver striking Shon Nelson in the left tricep. Officer Harris fired after identifying himself as a police officer and ordering Mr. Nelson to place his hands in the air. Officer Harris and his partner were responding to a call of a man with a gun. They were dealing with several subjects all of whom complied with the officers' commands, except Mr. Nelson. Mr. Nelson continued to walk away from Officer Harris, keeping one hand in his waist area. At the moment just before Officer Harris fired his weapon, Mr. Nelson made a sudden movement turning toward the officer. A weapon (fully loaded, Rossi .32 caliber revolver) was recovered from the area where Mr. Nelson was placed on the ground after being injured.

Assistant District Attorney Lovell Johnson and I had responsibility for reviewing the circumstances surrounding this incident. That review indicates that Officer Harris' actions were privileged in the exercise of self-defense and the defense of others under Section 939.48 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
