Dear Ms. Goodwin:

We have received your claim in the amount of \$114.05, relating to damage allegedly sustained to your vehicle on April 27, 2011 while it was parked in the garage at 2333 North 49th Street.

Our investigation reveals that the Police Facilities records indicate that they had a number of parking spaces barricaded to protect vehicles from falling concrete and material leaking through several joints. As soon as they knew that barricades had been improperly moved by someone to park in these spaces, they moved the barricades back. There is no evidence that the City was negligent in this matter. As such, the City would not be liable. Therefore, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
