The city charges me for snow removal. Snow plows remove snow from the street and dump much of it where I am required to remove it. This snow is compacted and difficult to remove; it also contains small stones and debris.

I am a 74 year old physically disabled widow. Physical activity such as snow removal requires a period of rest and physical recuperation for me.

I remove snow early. When the plows come through they "plow me in". I use my snow blower and my gasoline and oil mixture. My machine gets approximately 1 hour of running time on one gallon of gas.

Winter of 2003

Feb. 12 Remove snow after snowplow went through 1/2 hour
Physical recuperation 1 1/2 hours

March 5 Remove snow dumped by snow plows 1 hr 10 min.
Physical recuperation 3 hours

March 6 Someone's car had been parked in front of my house yesterday when plow came through. I was again "plowed in". Removal 1 hour
Physical Recuperation 3 hours

10 hours of snow removal and physical recuperation at \$10.00 per hour \$100.00

Gasoline was purchased on 12/13/02 at 1.499 per GAL.
1.499 X 2 HRS 40 MIN = \$3.99
