File # 030660 is a resolution relative to the application, acceptance and funding of the STD/HIV Prevention Training Grant.

# Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) to accept and fund the STD/HIV Prevention Training Grant project from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control through the Cincinnati Health Department (CHD).
- 2. This is a continuing grant.

# **Discussion**

- 1. The purpose of this project is for the MHD STD/HIV clinic to serve as a model training center for students and professionals enrolled in the STD/HIV Prevention Training Center in Cincinnati.
- 2. The CHD provides on-site opportunities for learning regarding STD/HIV diagnosis and management relative to numbers of clients served and diagnostic technology used. MHD, through the Central Health Clinic, will be a partner/affiliate of the CHD program to provide "hands-on" diagnostic training in STD/HIV diagnosis.
- 3. This grant will enable a partnership between the CHD and MHD to develop opportunities for resource sharing with the Milwaukee provider community. Enrollment in the Cincinnati training program is open to providers in Milwaukee.
- 4. A MHD Nurse Practitioner coordinates all training activities at the CHC.
- 5. This grant encompasses the period of April 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003.

# Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total of this grant is \$35,369, entirely from the grantor.
- 2. This grant will support the salary of 1 Nurse Practitioner, SG 670 @ .5 FTE and fringe benefits.
- 3. Travel and training is budgeted for \$6,000.

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
