NOTICE OF INJURY AND CLAIM


To the Officers of the County and City of Milwaukee and the Public Works  
Administration

You are hereby notified that pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Secs., 893.80 and 62.25, Penny Lee Walden of 2200 North Martin Luther King Drive, Apartment B35, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53212, hereby submits a claim to the City of Milwaukee for great injury and damage to her person she suffered on January 4, 2003 by reason of negligent failure to maintain city sidewalks and lift grates which resulted in her falling on the sidewalk as she walked down the street

The incident occurred as follows: Ms. Walden was walking down the sidewalk of North 2nd Street and Wisconsin Avenue in the City of Milwaukee. The sidewalk was not leveled at the point where the lift grate and sidewalk met. Ms. Walden's foot got caught at this point and she fell on her face, causing injury to Ms. Walden's body and face. There was not warning signs concerning the uneven sidewalk.

The City and its Officers are hereby notified that Ms. Walden, demands satisfaction for the physical injuries suffered to her in the amount of \$50,000, pursuant to Wisconsin Stats. Sec. 893.80(3) from the City and County.
