This report was dictated by Detective Michele HARRISON, assigned to the Criminal Investigation Unit/Internal Affairs Division (CIU/IAD), early shift.

ALLEGATION:

The complainant, Clifton DAVIS, states after an auto and foot chase he was hiding in the bushes when the police found him. Mr. DAVIS alleges the first police officer struck him several times with a closed fist to his nose and face and a second police officer struck him with a flashlight to the back of his head and left knee causing pain.

INVESTIGATION:

In an interview with Det. Michele HARRISON, Mr. DAVIS stated he was driving and the police came behind him and attempted to stop him. He stated he continued to drive and drove down a dead end street and parked and ran southbound through a field and gangway and hid in some bushes. He indicated the police found him and started beating on him. He states the police officer who was originally chasing him, P.O. ELM, struck him several times with a closed fist to his nose and face area, as he partner, P.O. JANKOWSKI, struck him with his flashlight to the head and the left knee. Mr. DAVIS states there were two different police officers and they were also holding his legs. He was then subsequently arrested and handcuffed and put into the van. Mr. DAVIS indicated he

never resisted with the police and denied attempting to disarm any police officer. Mr. DAVIS was arrested for Disarming a Police Officer, Resisting an Officer, OAR, Fleeing, Possession of Controlled Substance (marijuana) and Unregistered Auto.

CONCLUSION:

On Thursday, January 18, 2001, Det. Bradley KUST took this case to the District Attorney's office and it was reviewed by Assistant District Attorney Ken BERG. The defendant, Clifton DAVIS, was in custody at the time and was charged with Resisting an Officer, Fleeing and State OAR. Based on this information gathered throughout this investigation there are currently no sufficient findings to indicate any officer acted criminally while conducting their investigation. Based on Assistant DA Ken BERG'S disposition, this case will be cleared as unfounded.
