The Removal of:

“No Parking 2:00 AM to 10:00 AM. Two-Hour Meter Parking 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday-Friday, One dollar and fifty cents per hour.”

If you have no objection to the above, we will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee so that you may support it to final passage.

To reduce crashes on South 35<sup>th</sup> Street at the intersection of West Oklahoma Avenue, the north median is being removed to provide for the installation of a left turn lane southbound at the intersection. The installation of a left turn lane will push the through lanes into the existing parking lanes requiring the installation of no parking on both sides of South 35<sup>th</sup> Street to maintain two lanes each direction to a point 160 feet north of West Oklahoma Avenue.
