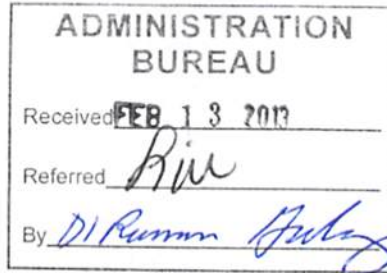

**NARRATIVE SECTION:**This report is typed by Police Officer Michael LEES, assigned to the First District, Late Shift.

On Saturday, January, 26<sup>th</sup>, 2013, at 12:03am, while assigned to squad 1341, I was dispatched to a Noise Complaint at 622 N Water St(Club 618 live on water/ Lady bug club).

Upon arrival I went to the Hilton Garden located at 611 N Broadway. The complaint/caller was later identified as being Diresha TAYLOR(F/B,01/06/88, # 277-7622) who is employed as a Security Officer for said business. TAYLOR stated that she was making her rounds throughout the hotel at about 11:45PM, and heard bass and loud music coming into the westside of the building in the basement. TAYLOR stated that she then went outside into the alley and noticed that the business to the west of them was playing very loud music. The business was Club 618. TAYLOR then notified her boss, Kanitra MURPHY(F/B, 01/06/88, #271-6611) who was instructed by the GM Lisa FARRELL to call the police. MURPHY, TAYLOR all wanted to press charges. MURPHY who is the Night Auditor stated that this isn't the first time they had this problem, that this is an ongoing problem and that they've had to comp people's rooms because of the music. MURPHY stated, that tonight people were enjoying an Art gallery and people were complaining about the noise as well. MURPHY stated that she'd probably have to comp people again in the morning because of the club's music.

I then asked if I could go where they heard the music. I was escorted by TAYLOR who had taken me to the first floor hallway which leads to the alley's exit. I could hear at approximately 12:09am, loud music, bass inside the concrete structure hotel. I was approximately 30 feet away from the exit door. Leading outside was an alley that's behind the Club. The alley is about 20 feet wide.

I then went to Club 618 Live on water(Lady Bug Club) located at 622 N Water St(sometimes they go with the address of 618 N Water St) and spoke with the owner, later identified as being Habib MANJEE(I/M, 07/16/64) who stated that the music was fine and that he has no bass in the back. It should be noted that in the front of the building I could hear, with the doors closed and cars passing by, his music and bass on the sidewalk. MANJEE stated he wanted to hear for himself the music and demanded to know who the complaint was. MANJEE stated the front of the building didn't count and that he hired a professional to do sound checks and that he's asked numerous times to speak with the Hotel management. I along with MANJEE then walked in the alley where I could still hear the music and feel the bass. I also heard a subject over a PA system yelling something in the Club. MANJEE stated, "What this is fine I see no problem!" I then instructed MANJEE that the music was unacceptable and that there was a complaintant that wanted a citation issued. At that time MANJEE became upset, stated that the police, the alderman were out to get him and are trying to close down his establishment. MANJEE said I was a one tracked police officer and only took one side of the story and that he was going to start calling on the hotel. MANJEE further stated that he wanted a supervisor because he didn't like how I was investigating this assignment. MANJEE said, "I'm going to pay burns to sit in front of the hotel and go inside" In an attempt to hurt the hotel.

Sgt. Scott RANDOW then arrived on scene at which time the music was still very loud. I was then instructed to do a tavern report and Per Captain Stephen BASTING I was not to issue a citation at this time.

At the request of Captain Basting, Mr. Habib Manjee, owner of the Ladybug Club/618, attended a meeting to discuss licensed premise issues at his business located at 618 N. Water St. In attendance were: owner Habib Manjee, Captain Stephen Basting and Michele Klingbeil - Event Planning. The meeting was held on Wednesday, January 30, 2013 at 3:00 p.m. in the First District Captain's office on the second floor of the Police Administration Building.

The complaints of excessive noise in the alley behind the club adjacent to the Hilton Garden Hotel have encouraged Mr. Manjee to invest in adding insulation inside his club. He has checked the decibel levels of other clubs and has made attempts to gain access to the hotel to measure the noise levels – without success.

Mr. Manjee has added another level of security to include monitoring the alley and streets around the club. He conducts a "roll call" with his security force of 12-15 each weekend night and addresses issues that arise. He closely monitors his many cameras and also goes out on the street to assess the situation, refusing admittance to problem customers. Mr. Manjee was very complimentary of Sgt. Scott Charles and his efforts to monitor the activities near the club. He also mentioned that a good portion of the pedestrian and vehicular traffic at bar closing time is coming from Water St. and Milwaukee St. clubs.

Captain stated that Mr. Manjee is one of the best business owners in the downtown district when it comes to maintaining a presence at his club. His active presence saves on police resources that would otherwise have to be deployed in the area. The situation has improved since Club Bari closed; however, the hotel has high expectations for their customers' safety and comfort.

Mr. Manjee stated that he has a great deal of respect for the department, particularly Captain Basting, and will continue to work with everyone to provide a safe and comfortable entertainment environment.

This report is submitted by P.O. Paul BJORKQUIST, assigned to District One, Squad 1243, 3:00PM-11:00PM.

On Sunday, June 2, 2013, at 2:13AM, while on duty, assigned to the downtown Code Red Deployment, I responded to a confirmed shooting at the address of 225 E Michigan Street, in the rear parking lot. Upon my arrival I spoke with the victim, Cortez CANFIELD, B/M, 11-28-88, who stated he had been shot by an unknown B/M during a fight in this lot, after he had exited the club "618 Live on Water." I observed a small gunshot wound to his lower, right side waist area.

On Sunday, June 2, 2013, at approx 3:00PM, I responded to 611 N Broadway, the Hilton Gardens Hotel, and obtained video of the above shooting which revealed (4) unknown B/Ms exit a SUV at approximately 1:02AM and walk west to the alley between N Water Street and N Broadway.

On Tuesday, June 4, 2013, at 11:19PM, I responded to 622 N Water St, which is the location of the club "618 Live on Water" and met with Habib MANJEE, I/M, 7-16-64, and obtained video surveillance footage which shows the same (4) B/M suspects who were observed on the video obtained from the Hilton Gardens Hotel, enter the club at 1:07AM. These same (4) B/M suspects return to the SUV at approximately 1:55AM after exiting the club. These suspects are observed on video surveillance footage fighting with the victim and witnesses immediately prior to the shooting.

MANJEE assisted in identifying the (4) B/M suspects/patrons of "618 Live on Water" through the archives of the photo I.D. system which he utilizes. (2) of the (4) B/M suspects were not required to scan their photo I.D. cards at the door on the night of the shooting because they frequent the club often. With MANJEE'S assistance all of the (4) B/Ms have been identified.

This case remains under investigation.



This report is being written by P.O. Bradley assigned to District One Power Shift.

On Friday July 5th, 2013 at 12:59am, While on directed patrol of the area of 622 N. Water St. (618) Sqd 1420, P.O. Christopher Martin and I were in the alley between N Water St and N Broadway and E. Michigan and E. Clybourn St. While driving northbound in the alley P.O. Martin and I heard 4 gunshots in the area just north/east of our location. P.O. Martin got out of the vehicle and went through the parking lot east towards N. Broadway. As I drove our marked squad northbound through the alley and on to Michigan St.

I observed several subjects crossing the street and one subject being carried. As I approached the subjects P.O. Martin was coming over the radio with a confirmed shooting. I approached the two victims and observed that victim 1 later identified as Desmond D. Smith B/M, 01/26/96, who had a gun shot wound to the stomach, I assessed him and made sure he was not further injured. I Looked at P.O. Martin and his victim identified as Jubre T. Miller, M/B, 08/20/94, who I could see was having heavy blood loss from his right upper leg. I advised P.O. Martin to take over with my victim and I began to assess Miller. I advised Miller to lie down and lift his leg. Miller was still loosing a good amount of blood so I used his belt to make a tourniquet and the bleeding slowed. At this point in time MFD came onto scene and took over medical treatment. The victims were laying on the ground about 16 feet from the corner of Michigan and Broadway. P.O. Martin asked Miller why he was in an area with bars even though he was not at the legal drinking age and Miller stated that Smith and himself were walking in the area of Club 618 because they knew there were going to be "HOES" (woman) in the club and wanted to holler at them (talk to them).

P.O. Martin Spoke to Myron Q. Smith (Brother of Desmond Smith) who stated that he was inside Club 618 with friends from Miller record label. Miller record label were the ones who brought in the rap group that performed at club 618. Myron Smith was informed by club 618 that his brother was shot outside.



This report is typed by PO CLINE, Jeffrey assigned to District One, Power-Shift. On 07/12/13, I PO CLINE and partner PO FJELD, Eric were part of the Code-Red Initiative, assigned to the location of 618 N. Water St. (Club 618)

At approximately 1:00 am, I observed multiple subjects actively fighting near the intersection of N. Water St. and E. Michigan Ave. I observed officers from Mounted Horse Patrol, Motorcycle Unit and Neighborhood Task Force attempting to disperse the crowd and break up the fight. I observed multiple subjects which included suspect later identified as WILKS, Anthony refusing orders from officers on scene to disperse. PO FJELD and myself assisted above listed officers in attempting to manage the scene. During this time I observed WILKS on the ground with NTF officers attempting to place him into custody. WILKS was eventually handcuffed and placed into our squad car. It appeared with his slurred speech and glassy eyes that WILKS was under the influence of intoxicants. I could also detect the overwhelming smell of burnt marijuana coming from the crowd that had refused to disperse. WILKS eventually calmed down and was released on scene.

At approximately 1:50 PO FJELD and myself heard the sound of one gunshot coming from the location near 630 N. Broadway. We were advised by witnesses that a subject in a white van had a gun. PO FJELD and myself observed a white van at that location and conducted a traffic stop. The driver was WILKS, Anthony and passenger CONNERS, Tramaine, m/b, 06/02/91. A loaded firearm (Ruger, 40 cal. semi-auto) was located underneath the drivers seat where WILKS was seated. WILKS was taken into custody on Endangering Safety by use of a Dangerous Weapon and OWI related charges. CONNERS was taken into custody on municipal warrants. It should be noted that while the traffic stop was being conducted, the sound of several more shots being fired could be heard to the south of our location. (250 E. Wisconsin Ave.) That incident is still under investigation.

During a Mirandized Interview, CONNERS stated that he was at Club 618 with WILKS. CONNERS stated he knew of the fight that was spilling outside of the club. He observed WILKS in the back of the squad car. CONNERS denied seeing WILKS with a gun but heard a shot being fired prior to the traffic stop and his arrest. CONNERS also stated he heard several more shots being fired in the direction near Club 618 while he was being detained. CONNERS also stated that WILKS was "wasted" drunk.

WILKS refused to give a statement.

**NARRATIVE SECTION:** At the request of Captain Basting, Mr. Habib Manjee, owner of the Club 618, attended a meeting to discuss licensed premise issues at his business located at 618 N. Water St. In attendance were: owner Habib Manjee, his attorney Mike Maistelman, Captain Stephen Basting, Lt. Liam Looney and Michele Klingbeil. The meeting was held on Tuesday, July 23, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. in the First District Captain's office on the second floor of the Police Administration Building.

Captain Basting started the meeting by mentioning that the recent shootings and shots fired incidents in the area surrounding the club are the first such incidents in 2 ½ years. In addition to the noise and clientele issues that have caused problems in the past, these most recent incidents have prompted discussion of a revocation of license request by the Hilton Garden Hotel.

Captain continued by telling Mr. Manjee that he has done everything he has asked of him including: adding another level of security to include monitoring the alley and streets around the club, adding insulation to increase the soundproofing, closely monitoring his many cameras, going out on the street frequently to assess the situation and refusing admittance to problem customers. Captain also stated that Mr. Manjee is one of the best business owners in the downtown district when it comes to maintaining a presence at his club. His active presence saves on even more police resources that would otherwise have to be deployed in the area. The situation has improved since Club Bari closed; however, the hotel has high expectations for their customers' safety and comfort and employees working there are in fear of losing their jobs if tourists do not want to stay there.

Mr. Manjee stated that he is also tired of the problems and has cancelled all of his outside promoters. In addition, he plans to close for a couple weeks in the fall to re-assess. He is looking at changing his venue to something other than the type of music that he currently offers and possibly returning to Electronic Dance Music and having a teen night that was successful in the past. Captain asked that he submit a written plan and Attorney Maistelman gave assurance that they would complete it this week.
