If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, lilegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. This report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5, Day Shift, Sq. 5142 with PO Eric MLODZIK.

On 10-05-22 at 9:00 a.m., we were dispatched to the location of 633 W. North Ave., in the city and county of Milwaukee for a report of a burglary.

This location is the Wendy's restaurant, which was open for business upon our arrival. The incident was captured on our body worn cameras.

We were met by the store franchisee, Deborah L. HENRY-YOUNG (b/f 11-21-65) and her general manager David J. AKINES (b/m 02-24-69). AKINES stated he came to work this morning and arrived around 5:30 a.m. He stated he normally parks his vehicle in the parking lot of the restaurant, on the south side of the building, but today he did not, due to the lot lights not working, so he parked his vehicle in the lot, north of the building, where the lot lights were working.

AKINES stated he walked into the restaurant, through a door on the north side of the building and realized the customer dining area was messy, causing him to believe that his night crew did not clean the customer dining area before closing the restaurant at 1:00 a.m. (10-05-22).

AKINES stated he entered the workers area, behind the customer counter and realized that the door leading into this area was open. He stated as he continued into the workers' area, he realized that the cash register near the drive through was damaged and that other doors in the workers' area were open. AKINES stated he grabbed a knife, due to not knowing if anyone was still in the restaurant and began the check for anyone still inside, but he did not locate anyone. He did tell us that the door to the manager's office was opened, he went on to tell us the safes are located here, as well as electrical panels (circuit breakers), which one the door to Panel B was open and the lever for the circuit breaker was still set to on. We were informed if Panel B was turned off, that the panel would control electrical for such items of water heaters, microwaves and other electrical devices, which may also have an effect on the security nadaliya inda 🕟 yayin andan dali kanan nadan da bara 🔻

cameras for the restaurant.

We were also informed that the actor had entered the restaurant through a door located on the southside of the restaurant, a window was broken to gain entry. We were also informed that the door latch to the door, where the window was broken, the door latch was not in proper working order and if someone had pulled hard enough, the door would open.

AKINES attempted to cue the video for us to watch. As he was doing this, we were met by HENRY-YOUNG, who is not the store owner, but the franchisee. She stated she has several Wendy's in the Milwaukee area.

While speaking with HENRY-YOUNG, she stated she is the franchisee of the Wendy's at this location, while the owner is under the last name of BRIDGEMAN. HENRY-YOUNG began helping the police trying to get the video from this incident from her video security company, who was going to email me a copy of the videos from this incident. While speaking to her, she stated her insurance company was Colony Insurance Company.

HENRY-YOUNG was able to assist us with the video from the cameras. She stated when she watched the video on her phone, she observed the actor walk west to her building, go to the south side door and break the glass, entering the restaurant. As the person was in the restaurant, she believed he had some kind of axe with him, using it to pry open the cash register drawers, as well as using the axe to enter the office. She stated the money is put into the safe every night and when the employees leave for the night, there is no money in the cash register drawers. She went on to tell me, due to other restaurants getting burglarized, her staff is supposed to leave the cash register drawers open, with no money, to show anyone breaking in that the cash registers have no money in them.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 6/6/2023 at 1:15 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
